

Dear Pre- Kindergarten Families,

It is our pleasure to welcome you and your child to School 16.

We have been busy preparing for the 2016-2017 school year. We are very excited for the start of the school year and look forward to meeting you in September. As you prepare for the school year, we would like to share the Pre-K's school supply list with you. Your child's book bag has to be large enough to hold a folder and store their extra clothes. Please no bag's with wheels. They will also need 2 lunch bags, 1 labeled lunch and 1 labeled snack.

The children will also be taking a nap during the school day. You will need to send in a towel or small blanket, no pillows, yoga mats or plastic mats. They must be sent in a labeled bag so they can be hung up and stored in the closet.

When purchasing school uniforms, please remember to purchase elastic waist pants if your child cannot zipper or button their pants independently. Your child should wear sneakers to school that fasten with VELCRO straps. Please remember to label all clothing, including sweaters and coats.

This is the Pre-Kindergarten supply list specialized for our school. You can also find it on the school website. Due to space in the classroom, we will ask you to replenish these supplies during the school year.

Please have the following supplies on the first day school. Each item should be labeled with your child's name. The following supplies will be kept in school and possibly shared with the class.

- 1 Clear pencil box to hold your supplies-please NO bags
- 2 Plastic folders – Heavy duty
- 2 Packs dry Erase wipe off marker (any color)
- 2 Packs of 24 Crayola crayons
- 1 Pack of Crayola markers

If your child is a boy we ask you to send in 1 box of quart size Ziploc bags and hand sanitizer.

If your child is a girl we ask that you send in 1 box of gallon size Ziploc bags and a roll of paper towels.

****REQUIRED 1 complete change of clothes (including underwear/panties) to be kept in your child's backpack at all times. Please put it in a Ziploc bag with your child's name on it.**

Pre-kindergarten Supply List

Please have the following supplies on the first day school. Each item should be labeled with your child's name. The following supplies will be kept in school and possibly shared with the class.

If your child is a girl we ask that you send in 1 box of gallon size Ziploc bags and a roll of paper towels.

****REQUIRED 1 complete change of clothes (including underwear/panties) to be kept in your child's backpack at all times. Please put it in a Ziploc bag with your child's name on it.**
