- If, prior to December 16, 2011, I applied for my child to be evaluated for the **Academically Talented Programs for Prekindergarten through grade 8** and my child is accepted, I understand that he/she will automatically be placed in the appropriate Academically Talented program. **I understand that if my child is accepted into the Academically Talented Program the District will not consider my application choices.**
- **I understand that eligibility for transportation is determined by the Yonkers Public Schools. Eligible students will be notified before school begins in September.
