<p><u>You have the right to...</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ An excellent education. 	<p><u>It is your responsibility to...</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Take ownership of your learning by <i>trying your best</i>. Success is about effort, not excellence ➤ Be on time for class, ready to follow all routines and procedures. ➤ Complete assignments to the best of your ability. ➤ Ask questions if you don't understand or attend extra help.
<p><u>You have the right to...</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Bring your cell phone/electronics to school 	<p><u>You have the responsibility to...</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Respect your teachers, and the schools, cell phone policy by following each classroom's phone policy. ➤ Stay off your phone during class UNLESS your teacher informs you that it is needed for instruction
<p><u>You have the right to...</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Speak freely without fear of being interrupted or insulted. 	<p><u>You have the responsibility to...</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Not interrupt anyone as they are speaking. ➤ Not make unnecessary comments that could embarrass or distract someone.
<p><u>You have the right to...</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Be valued as team members who have the right to be treated fairly and with respect. 	<p><u>You have the responsibility to...</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Afford others the same respect you want for yourself. ➤ Refrain from behavior which may hinder the achievement or safety of yourself or other students. ➤ Use appropriate language both in and out of the classroom. ➤ Keep your hands, feet, and objects to yourself. No physical contact.
