YOUR CHILD'S SCHOOL WILL CLOSE AT THE END OF THE 2024-2025 SCHOOL YEAR. HERE'S WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW.

Why is Museum School 25 Closing?

- Low Enrollment: Museum School 25 has the lowest enrollment in the district. This year, only 12 families selected it as their first choice.
- Building Costs: The school requires \$5.4 million in necessary repairs and upgrades.
- Academic Challenges: Museum School 25 has been in state accountability status for 15 years, with 85% of students below proficiency in reading and 97% in math.
- Better Opportunities: Yonkers Public Schools is a district of choice. Your child will have access to schools with stronger programs, more resources, and enhanced learning opportunities.

What Happens Next?

- Families will select a new school for their child through the Special Ballot process.
- Sibling preference will be honored whenever possible.
- There are open seats in nearby schools.
- Transportation will be provided for eligible students.
