San Diego has reserved plenty of outdoor space to enjoy the weather, from beaches and boardwalks to the fields and foot-paths of sprawling Balboa Park. This is a place where life is lived outdoors and outdoor adventures come to life. With its diverse ecological systems, it stands alone as a place where environmentalist can explore and learn.

Day 1 • Arrive in San Diego, CA

Arrive at the airport in San Diego and meet your Appleseed Expeditions guide. The group will check into its accommodations and have an introduction to the program.

Day 2 • Explore Tide Pools at Cabrillo National Monument Park

This morning, following breakfast, the group will head out with to study marine ecosystems along these famous southern California tide pools. In the afternoon you will volunteer with Feeding San Diego. They are the largest hunger-relief organization in the county, distributing healthy food to San Diego residents struggling with hunger.

Day 3 • Visit Famous San Diego Zoo

After an early breakfast your group will visit the San Diego Zoo. It's home to 3000-plus animals representing 800-plus species in a beautifully landscaped setting, including the new 7.5-acre Elephant Odyssey. Attractions include animal shows and an aerial tram.

Day 4 • Kayak La Jolla Sea Caves

Discover by kayak the spectacular sea cliffs, the Seven Caves and

the La Jolla Underwater Parkland its abundant marine life including Sea Lions, Leopard Sharks, and Garibaldi.

Day 5 • Visit Birch Aquarium at Scripps

Birch Aquarium at Scripps is the public exploration center for the world-renowned Scripps Institution of Oceanography at UC San Diego. Perched on a bluff overlooking the Pacific Ocean, the aquarium features more than 60 habitats of fishes and invertebrates from the cold waters of the Pacific Northwest to the tropical waters of Mexico and beyond. An oceanographic museum showcases research discoveries by Scripps scientists on climate, earth and ocean science and includes five dozen interactive elements.



Day 6 • The Journey Home

This morning the group will get packed up and head to the airport for the trip home.
