
A Special Note on Wikipedia

Criteria for Evaluating Websites

Main Criteria	Descriptions/Details	Possible Answers
Author	Who is providing the information? What do you know about them and their credentials, are they an expert? Can you find out more and contact them? Search for author or publisher in search engine. Has the author written several publication on the topic?	User generated, journalist, varies greatly, none given/no, NA, Scholars in research
Publisher/ Affiliation	Is there a sponsor or affiliation? Who is linking to the page? Do they take responsibility for the content?	Credible publisher, yes but doesn't take responsibility, NA, questionable publisher questionable responsibility, Yes but not credible, yes but not necessarily credible
Bias/ Balance/ Purpose	Is the language free of emotion? Does the organization or author indicate there will be bias? Is the website to inform or spread an agenda? Are there ads?
