Improving these skills is one of the best investments you can make. When you read regularly, you become a better reader. There are no shortcuts.

Good intentions often fail when one doesn't have a plan. Read before you go to sleep. If you notice that you fall asleep when you read, read in the morning when you wake up. Aim for at least half an hour of reading each day.

We have spent time in class reading your book and reviewing your *Summer Book Club Assignment*. Give yourself a chance to get lost in the story, to fight your desire to skip to the final pages to find out what happens, to meet new characters that you will remember forever.
