## DIALECTICAL JOURNAL

ASSIGNMENT: MUST BE TYPED, TIMES NEW ROMAN, 12 PT FONT DUE DATE: WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 12, 2018

- As you read your book, <u>select FIVE significant passages</u> that span the entire book (beginning, middle, and end). Your selection should be a minimum of five sentences. <u>Identify the passage page</u> <u>number</u>.
- 2. For each passage you select, <u>write at least one comment</u> about why you chose the passage:
  - > Did the passage impress, intrigue, horrify, or puzzle you?
  - > Did you find the author's use of language appealing or powerful?
  - > Did the passage jump off the page as a great descriptive passage?
  - > Did you find yourself in agreement/disagreement with the ideas expressed?
  - > Did the passage remind you of a situation you lived as well?
  - > Did the passage provoke an emotional response?
  - > Did the author raise intriguing questions or issues?
  - > Did the passage challenge or expand your thinking?

You are not limited to the above list nor are you expected to answer all of the above. Your comments/responses to the passages should clearly explain WHY these passages mean something to you - WHY these passages caught your attention.

- 3. In the end, <u>write a ONE PAGE REFLECTION</u> about your Summer Book Club reading experience.
- 4. Vocabulary: You will be responsible for keeping a running list of at least ten

<u>new vocabulary words</u> that you encounter while reading your book. The list first needs to be written down and the new terms defined. Finally, submit a neat, typewritten version of the list.
