

HOW TO USE SEESAW AS A STUDENT

Log in as a Student

1. Open the Seesaw class app.
2. Tap "I'm a student".
3. Tap the blue "scan code" button and scan the QR for the class.
4. Students choose their name from the list.

Post Student Work from Scratch

Click Add →



Photo: take photo of work

Video: record yourself or your work

Upload: for uploading a file, photo, or video that was taken on your device instead of directly through Seesaw

Notes: for typing a message

Link: for linking a webpage (not likely to be used)
