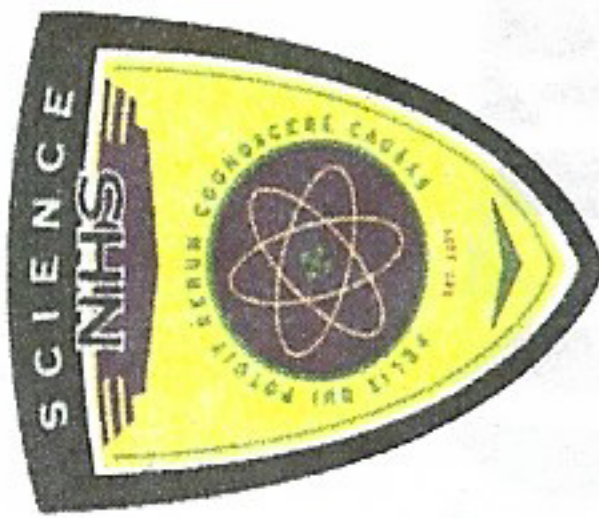

What are we looking for in a National Honor Society Candidate?

- Outstanding students who will be challenged to further develop and achieve through involvement
- Students who demonstrate the personal qualities of Leadership, Character, Scholarship and Service

The Process:

- All students with an academic average of **85%** and above for **1st** and **2nd** marking periods will be invited to participate. Participation doesn't guarantee induction into the society.
- Students will be required to attend monthly meetings, perform community services, produce individual and group projects and demonstrate excellence in the **4** key areas of the society.
- After review, the faculty council will recommend and vote on those students who should be inducted into the society.
- Students chosen for membership will be inducted into the NHS at a formal induction ceremony.

Probationary students can join in grades 9-10.

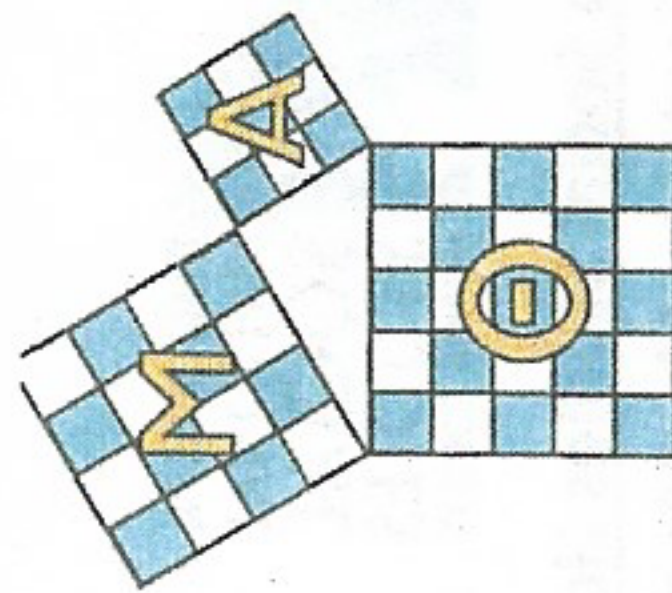
Students are inducted into SNHS in grades 11-12, provided they meet the requirements.

Dues: \$10 per year for both probationary and inducted members

Volunteer Hours: 10 per year

- Must participate in at least **2** school events per year, examples: Science Fair, Earth Day and Hudson River Day
- Must maintain **80** average in all classes
- Must maintain **80** average in Regents Science classes
- Must take science for **4** years in high school
- Must sit for 3 Science Regents exams, must pass **2** or more Science Regents exams. One Science Regents must be **80** or better.

- **Students are encouraged to join the STEAM Team for community service opportunities.**

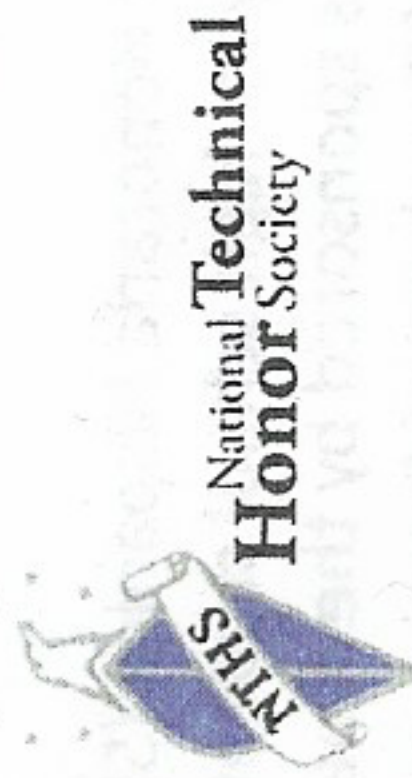

Minimum of **90** or higher in the technical subject for **2** consecutive semesters.

- **15** hours of volunteer service, if not a senior
- **40** hours, if a senior
- **After induction:**
 - Maintain average of **85** or higher GPA
 - **40** hours of community service

Minimum of **\$30** to join
