Following Directions

Read each direction to your child. You may need to repeat the directions or help your child to complete each action.

You can use these as flash cards, games, or just practice by reading them out loud and asking your child to follow the direction.

Some ways you can support following directions in everyday activities:


- Encourage your child to help you with tasks "bring me the cup" or "go get your shoes"
- Practice games such as Simon Says to have your child follow simple directions in a fun way

Directions can have one step (where they need to follow one thing), two steps (where there are two things they need to do), or multi-step (where there are many things they need to do).

You can make directions more challenging by adding in steps or making them more complex or specific. For example, you could say "get your shoes" or you could say "get your blue shoes and bring them to the front door."


You can help your child to follow directions by repeating them (saying them again), giving them one step at a time, or pointing, showing, or giving them an item to help. Pictures can also help to clarify if needed.


- 1. After you color the tree leaves green, color the tree trunk brown.
