*TENTATIVE SCHOOL HYBRID MODEL RE-OPENING DATE

- Students will receive instruction remotely 5x per week (excluding holidays)
- Related services are provided remotely
- Social emotional learning and supports are integrated into the instructional program and will be delivered remotely
- Wednesday's are for teacher follow-up with students and families as well as for professional development
- Digital instructional platforms such as Microsoft Teams, NearPod, and Castle Learning, will be used for remote learning.
- Microsoft Teams will be used as the main platform for communication and direct instruction

SOCIAL AND EMOTIONAL WELL-BEING

- Pupil Support Team Members (School Social Worker, School Psychologist, School Counselors and Nurses) will be available to address students' needs and prepare socially responsive support systems
- Student and Parent Virtual orientations and presentations will be held prior to school opening and throughout the school year
- Grade Level assistant principals and school counselors will hold weekly grade level assemblies/check-ins on Microsoft Teams

ATTENDANCE

Per NYSED guidance district policies and procedures must focus on the academic consequences of lost instructional time and address absences before students fall behind in school. It is critical for schools to use a variety of creative methods to reach out to students and their families who have not engaged in distance learning.

Attendance Tracking and Reporting

- Teachers must track attendance in PowerSchool, whether students are attending at schools or engaging from home
- Teachers will take attendance for each class period
- For students engaging from home, the District recommends teachers give a daily attendance assignment or exit ticket in Microsoft Teams, then mark students that complete the assignment as engaged in PowerSchool

Chronic Absenteeism

- Reports are readily available in PowerSchool to assist schools in identifying students at-risk of chronic absenteeism, so as to develop interventions, problem solve with families, and improve attendance
- Individual school plans will include additional details on systems and processes for detection and intervention here at Lincoln all conversations, meetings, and other forms of communication must be documented on “Log Entries” on the student's page in PowerSchool

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5 Required Regents Exams

A total of 22 credits are required to graduate. A student identified as having an educational disability may be excused from the Language Other Than English (L.O.T.E.) requirement if such student's Individual Education Plan (IEP) indicates that such requirements are not appropriate for the student's special educational needs.
