Grade 2 Project Entries

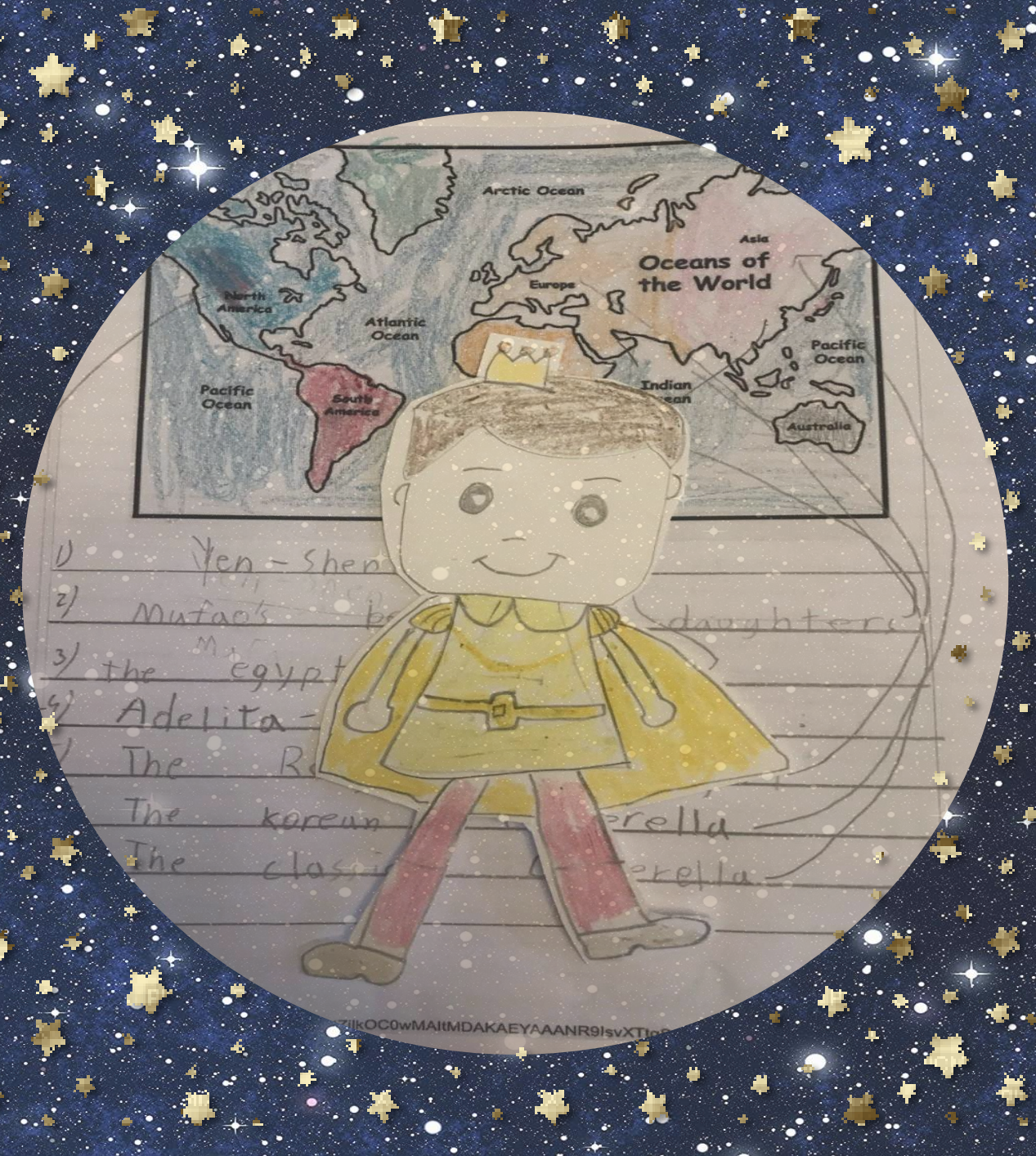
Learning Target:

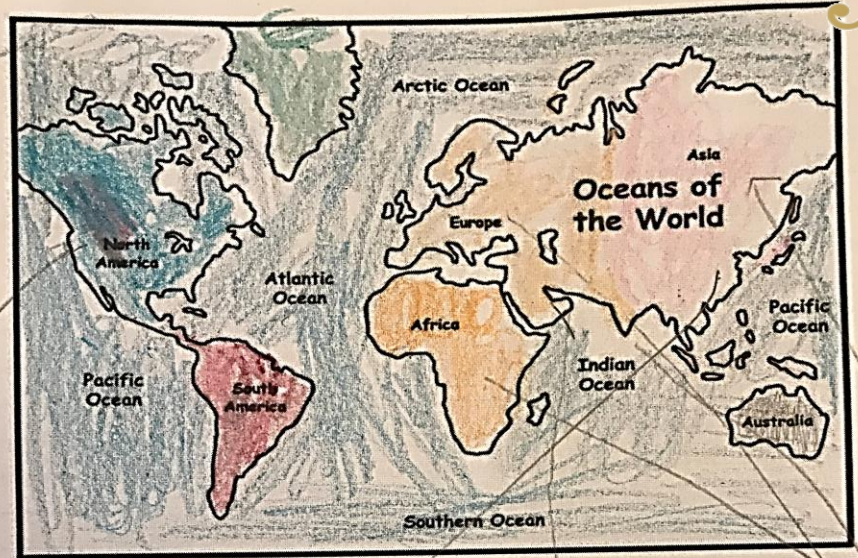

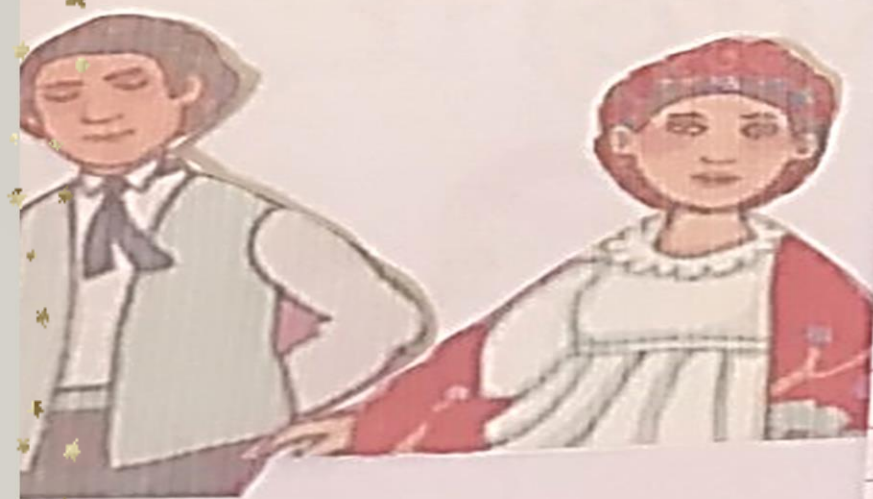
