

Please see the college/post-secondary planning checklist for senior year from our YPIE Center. Please use the checklist as a guide and path that will lead to your college planning/post-secondary plans:

September 2020

	Review for SAT/ACT Exams
•	Meet with your school counselor/YPIE advisor to discuss the college application process.
•	Visit college campuses/participate in virtual college visits, and schedule interviews.
•	Create a professional email account and begin to check it. (i.e. School email – Office 365)
•	Setup a calendar system that works for you
•	Follow up with teachers and counselor about letters of recommendation
•	Continue to volunteer and stay involved in extra-curricular activities
•	Work on college essay and resume
•	Start collecting financial documents for FAFSA/TAP applications, create and FSA ID
•	Research and apply for scholarships
October 2020	
•	File FAFSA/TAP beginning Oct. 1st
•	Register for SAT/ACT exams
•	Send test scores to colleges you are applying to
•	Finalize your college list
•	Register for an account on commonapp.org
•	Start working on your supplements in Common Application (if applicable).
•	Continue working on your college essay and resume and upload it onto Naviance
•	Be aware of and talk with counselors about Early Decision/Early Action deadlines
•	Attend college visits/schedule interviews
	November 2020
•	Register for upcoming SAT/ACT
•	Be aware of college application deadlines. Do not wait until the last minute to submit your
	applications
•	Follow-up with teachers and counselors regarding recommendation letters
•	Complete college essay and resume
•	Sign FERPA Waiver in Naviance using Common Application email if you have not already done
	so
•	Submit FAFSA/TAP applications
•	If you submitted applications, follow-up with colleges and check to see that all your materials
	were received
•	Visit colleges virtually/set up virtual interviews with colleges
•	Make sure all colleges you've applied to are listed in your Naviance account
