- Please speak politely and respectfully to all students and teachers.
- Please raise your hand if you have a question or need help.

- Use kind, supportive words. We are here to support each other and learn new things.
- **Remember that everyone has their own art style!** We are respectful of everyone's unique art type.

COMMUNITY

- Work together to clean up and keep the class organized.
- Clean up your table and help each other as a team.
- Support and respect everyone's art process!

<u>For our first project, please create a "Name Tag".</u>

These name tags will be used in the classroom when we return to school, and you can continue to work on them and add to them until we all meet in person. For this project you can write your name and

decorate with pictures, words, colors, or designs that are special to you. Some ideas to include are:

- Your favorite hobbies
- Sports
- School subjects
- Animals
- Cartoon, TV, or video game characters
- Colors
- Shapes
- Words

<u>Materials:</u>

A piece of paper







• An Eraser



 Something to color with (Crayons, Markers, highlighters, or Colored Pencils)



 Optional: glue, magazine images, stickers, or anything you have at home that you would like to include on your name tag.



Name Tag Steps!

(We will work on this together!)



Turn your paper so that it is vertical. Let's talk about what vertical means!

"Vertical" means that the paper is turned so that it is tall and narrow.



Step Two:

Fold your paper in half.

Step Three:

Write your name on the folded paper.



Step Four:

Decorate your name tag with images, words, pictures, colors, or shapes.



Step Five:

Keep your nametag safe for when you return to school. You can keep adding to it for as long as you would like to for the month of September. When we return to school, we will start adding stars to this name tag!
