Greetings Yonkers Montessori Academy Families:

On behalf of the administrative team, teachers and staff, we look forward to a great opening of school. The first day of school for all Kindergarten through 12th grade students is Tuesday, September 6, 2022. Our school day begins at 7:35 a.m. and ends at 2:15 p.m. The first full day for all Pre-K students is Thursday, September 8, 2022. Our learning community is a comprehensive academy of over 1,250 students. As such, we want to make our school as safe as we can. We would like to reduce the traffic in our immediate school vicinity and ask that if you must drop off or pick up, that you arrive early enough to find a legal parking area away from the school building. We do not have a driveway or visitor parking lot. Our driveway is the only accessible entrance we have for our students with disabilities and therefore we ask that parents do not pull in, drive through or block our parking lot entrance, as it is an active drive way for our accessible vehicles. To provide adequate supervision, our doors open at 7:25 daily.

PK-3 students must enter the building at 99 Wakefield Avenue.

Grades 4-6 enter at 160 Woodlawn Avenue

Grades 7-8 enter through the gym doors (Hyatt Avenue)

Grades 9-12 enter through the Stairwell 4 entrance (Athletic Field)

Dismissal is at 2:15 p.m. daily. Your child's teacher (PK-6) will have specific directions about their dismissal procedures. Check the YMA website, Instagram or Twitter regularly for up-to-date information. Please reach out to your child's assistant principal if you have any questions.
