REMOTE LEARNING

- Remote learning, whether your child is HYBRID or IN-PERSON, requires the same attention as IN SCHOOL LEARNING.
- Students are expected to log into classes on time and be prepared like any other day.
- Active learning starts with the students being attentive with a live view.
- Participation is MANDATORY.
- Students who do not fully engage, go live, or leave the class will not receive attendance or credit for the class.



EXPECTATIONS FOR HYBRID LEARNING

- 1. Teachers can live stream to students who are at home Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday so that they can participate in the live lessons being taught. Community time is to check in and ensure that students in all cohorts are socially and emotionally well and to ensure that there is time to assess that students have met the learning objectives for the lesson.
- 2. A second modality is to have **teachers pre-record lessons**. While the live group is in the classroom being instructed live by the teacher, **the students at home would be watching the same the lesson that has been pre-recorded**. Options also include available videos we access through digital resources to supplement lessons.
- 3. Another modality is to have teachers **post lessons directly into Teams**. Students at home would **work independently** on assignments and then **check in** with the teacher for understanding during community meeting time. The posted lessons should ensure **Continuity of Instruction** for students in All Tracks.



HEALTH SCREENING AND CHECKS

- Begin the Health Screening at HOME. Parents are RESPONSIBLE for checking their child's temperature and completing the COVID-19 Questionnaire at HOME DAILY.
- The DAILY COVID-19 QUESTIONNAIRE may be completed ONLINE. A Link is provided on our webpage starting Monday. Any response of a "YES" will require the student to be assessed by the School Nurse.
- Temperature Checks will occur **DAILY** as the students enter the building. If a reading of 100.1 or higher will have the student referred to the School Nurse immediately.
- Face Masks MUST BE WORN EVERY DAY. We will not compromise on ANYONE'S HEALTH AND SAFETY! Repeated refusal by a student will have the student moved to TRACK D.



OCTOBER 5th and BEYOND

- MASKS WORN ALL DAY AND EVERY DAY.
- SOCIAL DISTANCING IS MANDATORY AT ALL TIMES.
- 9th & 10th STUDENTS WILL ENTER THROUGH THE UPPER LOBBY DOORS.
- 11th & 12th STUDENTS WILL ENTER THROUGH THE LOWER LOBBY DOORS.
- NO STUDENT ENTRY BEFORE 7:30 AM DAILY DRESS FOR THE WEATHER WITH COATS AND/OR UMBRELLAS AS NEEDED.
- NO LOCKERS AND NO LUNCH BAGS.
- TEMPERATURE AND COVID-19 QUESTIONNAIRES MUST START AT HOME. STATIONS WILL BE MANNED AT BOTH ENTRANCES.



OCTOBER 5th and BEYOND

- DESKS IN THE CLASSROOM HAVE BEEN STRATEGICALLY PLACED
- NO LUNCH TABLES IN THE CAFETERIA JUST DESKS.
- STUDENTS WON'T BE ALLOWED TO EXIT THE CAFETERIA DURING THEIR SHIFT.
- STAIRWELLS 1 & 3 ARE UP DIRECTION.
- STAIRWELLS 2 & 4 ARE DOWN DIRECTION.
- CODE OF CONDUCT WILL BE ENFORCED.
- STANDARD GRADING POLICY (BOE #4710) WILL BE FOLLOWED.
- STUDENTS WHO LEAVE CAMPUS WITHOUT PERMISSION MAY BE PLACED DIRECTLY IN TRACK D AT THE DISCRETION OF SCHOOL ADMINISTRATORS



BATHROOMS AND HALL PASSES

- STUDENTS ON 1ST AND 2ND FLOORS MAY USE THE 2ND FLOOR BATHROOM.
- STUDENTS ON 3RD & 4TH FLOORS MAY USE THE 4TH FLOOR BATHROOM.
- 2 STUDENTS MAY USE THE BATHROOM AT ONE TIME.
- PASSES ARE COLOR CODED TO ENSURE COMPLIANCE.
- STUDENTS MUST FOLLOW THE FLOW OF THE HALLWAY AND STAIRWELL AS INDICATED BY FLOOR AND WALL SIGNS.
- HAND SANITIZING STATIONS ARE LOCATED THROUGHOUT THE BUILDING
