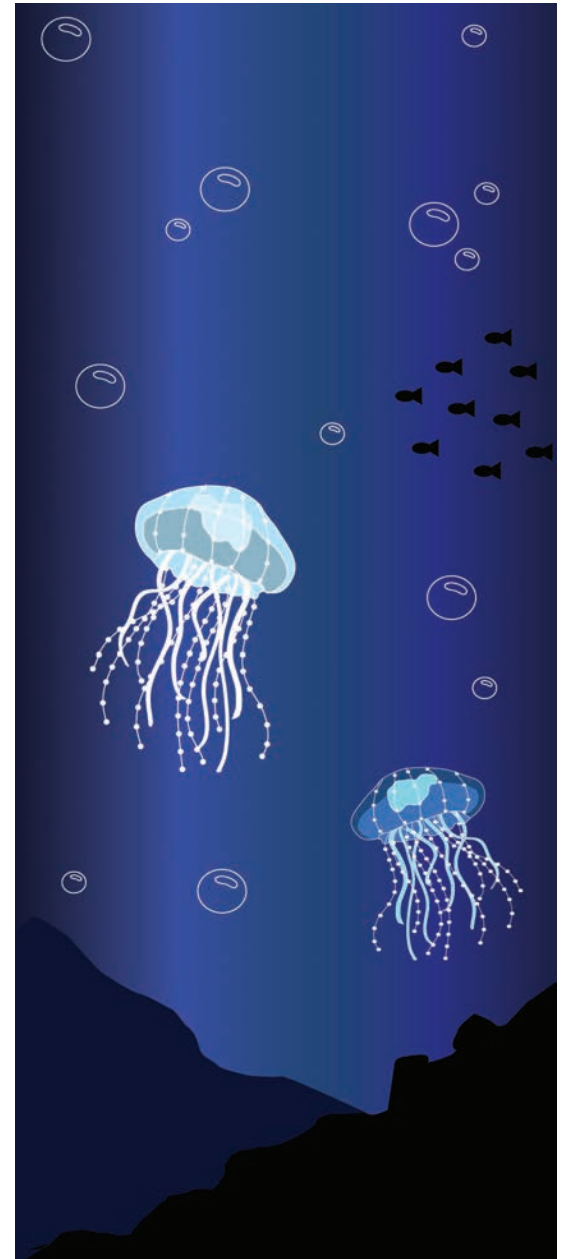
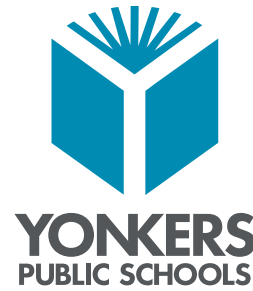

3. Create a free account on www.goodreads.com. Post a book review for the book that you read. Be sure to rate the book 1-5 stars
