## GIRLS WHO CODE CLUB VALUES

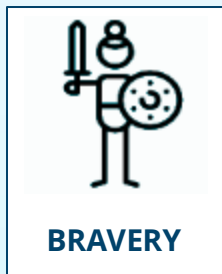
### SISTERHOOD
