### Classroom Procedures/Expectations

\*This is an accelerated class. We meet each day for a double period (90 minutes). We will start with the 8<sup>th</sup> grade curriculum then begin the Algebra 1 Common Core material. The students will be eligible to take the Algebra 1 Common Core Regents exam in June and receive credit for high school if they pass both the class and the regents. \*We are a community of learners. I want your children to take risks in the classroom. That is how they gain confidence. It is important that each student respects their peers and allows them the opportunity to take risks without being judged.

\*There is homework every night. I assign a project each month or every other month

## • Quizzes/Tests-

\*Khan Academy minutes count as one quiz grade per week along with at least one in class. Each unit will culminate with a test. They will ALL have to bring home and get signed by a parent/guardian no matter what the grade. I try to emphasize in class that quizzes/tests help me to know what we do well and what we need to work on. I like to spiral the curriculum daily. Each concept builds on previous concepts.
