<i>Title</i>	Peter and the Wolf: Travels of Prokofiev
<i>Subject</i>	Cn: Connecting
<i>Author</i>	Adapted from Maestro Classics
<i>Grade level</i>	5-8
<i>Time duration</i>	Self-Guided
<i>Overview</i>	Take a trip that mirrors Sergei Prokofiev's Travel Log
<i>Objective</i>	You will explore the places he visited and gain a deeper understanding of Prokofiev's experiences.

<i>Activities and procedures</i>	<p><b>Step 1</b> Read the Following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Visit, The <a href="#">Map of Prokofiev's Travels</a> to check out Prokofiev's travel route over his 20 years abroad.</li><li>• Investigate each place by looking it up on the internet: Petrograd (St. Petersburg), Siberia, Tokyo, New York, Chicago, Paris, London, Berlin, Brussels, Moscow. (Prokofiev certainly performed in more cities than listed, and visited many of them more than once. This is just an overview of some of his significant career travels.)</li></ul> <p><b>Step 2</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Create a Powerpoint or video newscast about one of the cities Prokofiev visited. Include interesting facts that would make someone want to visit.</li></ul>
