1/6 PNW BOCES PD for 6th-8th Grade Social Studies Teachers

This Zoom meeting will be facilitated by PNW BOCES curriculum writers and will review the parts of the program as well as how to use the lessons and activities during hybrid and full remote learning. This district-adopted Social Studies curriculum is fully digital and is designed and accessible for K-8 teachers. Microsoft Immersive Reader and One Note. This option provides training on how to use One Note to create assignments and student notebooks as well as how to differentiate for students through the use of immersive reading and translations functions.

1/13 Mystery Science for K-5th grade teachers. This Zoom meeting is facilitated by Mystery Science and provides a complete overview of the program and how to effectively use it during hybrid and full remote learning. (This is the same training that was conducted in December.)

America Through the Lens PD for High School US History Teachers. Cengage/National Geographic trainers will facilitate how to use the teacher text digital dashboard to enhance hybrid and full remote learning. (1:15-2:30 p.m.)

Microsoft Breakout Rooms. With virtual breakout rooms, meeting hosts can break participants into separate meeting rooms for small group discussion, then bring them back to the main meeting room.

1/27 PNW BOCES PD for 3rd-5th Grade Teachers. This Zoom meeting will be facilitated by PNW BOCES curriculum writers and will review the parts of the program as well as how to use the lessons and activities during hybrid and full remote learning.
