Cooperative Collection Development Plan

New York State Regulation 90.18 of the Commissioner of Education requires School Library Systems to create Cooperative Collection Development Plan as part of resource sharing among its member libraries. The plan will aid member libraries in cooperative collection development.

Goal

To maximize the resources available to member libraries.

Objectives

- 1. To develop library collections that support school magnet programs, curriculum or special client needs
- 2. Increase resource sharing among member libraries

Governance

The Director of Library Services will work collaboratively with the School Library System Council to

- 1. Review Inter-Library Loan procedures and make adjustments to facilitate service
- 2. Provide appropriate Professional Development
- 3. Provide book lists to diversify the collections and meet the magnet needs of each school
- 4. Provide information on possible grants to increase collections

Member Responsibilities

Members of the Yonkers City School Library System will:

- 1. Participate in resource sharing through inter-library loan
- 2. Attend professional development on literature and inter-library loan procedures
- 3. Apply for grants where possible

Evaluation

This Collection Development Plan will be evaluated by the Director of Library Services and the Yonkers city School Library Council based on information received from responses on School Library System Member Survey and Annual Library Report from each member school.
