SUMMER SESSION ELIGIBILITY

The summer session program is restricted to those students who have failed a course during the academic year and who were in good attendance in that class. Specifically, according to the District's Attendance Policy, a student may not have been absent more than **24 times** for a full credit course or more than **12 times** for a half (1/2) credit course.

GUIDELINES FOR COURSES AND CREDIT

- All courses are to be considered make-ups. They are not intended for acceleration or enrichment.
- Credits will be granted by the home school principal upon successful completion of each course. This policy also applies to students who take courses in any New York State approved out-of-district Summer Session program.
- Enrollment will be on a first-come, first-serve basis according to the registration schedule. However, priority will be given to 8th and 12th graders. When maximum class enrollment (30 students) is achieved, courses will be closed. Courses with enrollments of fewer than 15 students may be closed.
- All courses offered will be subject to District pupil/teacher ratio levels.
- Students may not take more than two courses with the exception of 8th graders and 12th graders. In such cases, special permission is required from their **home school principal in writing**.

PRE-REGISTRATION

The following documents are required to register:

- Student's report card.
- Completed Secondary Summer Session Pre-Registration Form signed by the home school principal and the parent/guardian.

- Yonkers Public Schools students and Yonkers Non-Public School students must bring the following in order to register: a signed registration form and a copy of their final report card. High School students must also bring a copy of their transcript.
- Out-of-District students (non-Yonkers residents) must bring the following: final report card, authorization from their school to attend Summer Session, and proof of residency.
Students who appear without these documents will not be permitted to register. There will be no student registration once the Summer Session program begins on July 5.

TUITION

There is a \$3.00 registration fee for all students. All non-resident students who wish to attend Yonkers Summer Session must pay \$300.00 per course for tuition plus the \$3.00 registration fee.

Registration and/or tuition are payable in cash, check or money order made out to: *Yonkers Public Schools Summer Session*. Full registration and/or tuition are due at registration. There will be no refunds unless the course is under-enrolled and closed.

ATTENDANCE

There will be twenty-six (26) days of instruction for all students enrolled in the Yonkers Summer Session. Instruction begins on July 5 and ends on August 15. Final Examinations are scheduled for August 14, 15. Students with absences and/or tardiness in a course exceeding **two (2)** instructional school days may not be permitted to take exams or receive any credit unless authorized by the Yonkers Summer Session Principal.

Tardiness to class up to fifteen minutes will be considered half an absence; more than fifteen minutes will be considered a full absence. Students will be allowed to stay for instruction. Parents/Guardians are requested to call the school between 8:30 a.m. and 11:30 a.m. on the day a student will be absent at (914) 376-8191. A note must accompany the student on their return to class.

REPORT CARDS

Progress reports will be mailed out during the week of July 24, 2023. On August 21, 2023, final report cards will be mailed to each parent and a copy will be sent to the home school. **It is the responsibility of the students from the non-public and out-of-district schools to furnish accurate information to where the copies of the final grades are to be sent.**
