HELP YOUR CHILD STAY COVERED!

If your child has Medicaid coverage, your Medicaid plan will be sending a letter regarding health insurance coverage.

WHAT CAN YOU DO TO MAKE SURE YOUR CHILD IS COVERED?



UPDATE YOUR CONTACT INFORMATION

If you enrolled in Medicaid through NY State of Health, make sure NY State of Health has your current mailing address, phone number and email address so they can contact you about your health insurance. **To update your information, call 1-855-355-5777.**

If you enrolled in Medicaid through Westchester County's Medicaid office, contact that office at 914-995-3333 to update your contact information.

Has your contact information changed? Contact the Westchester Social Services Department at 914-231-2100.



CHECK YOUR MAIL

You will receive a letter about your coverage. This letter will let you know if you need to complete a renewal form to see if you still qualify for Medicaid or CHIP.



COMPLETE YOUR RENEWAL FORM (if you get one)

Fill out the form and return it right away to help avoid a gap in your coverage.

If you lose Medicaid coverage, contact an enrollment assister immediately to see if you can re-enroll in Medicaid or check to see if you qualify for subsidized coverage through the ACA Marketplace.
