- Draw a self portrait that is part you on the outside, but also how you feel on the inside. Use paper from the blue bin (project paper) or ask me for larger paper if you need it. Draw in pencil, outline then color... other options include collage (magazines) or a painting... or a COMBO.
- Make a detailed drawing of a dollar bill but change 5 things.

Use paper from the blue bin (project paper). Draw in pencil then outline carefully with a black or green sharpie.

• Create a new Muppet.

Use paper from the blue bin (project paper) or ask me for larger paper if you need it. Draw in pencil, outline then color . . . DON'T FORGET to give your muppet a name (be original and purposeful . . . it's a name !!).

• Combine 3 existing animals to create a completely new animal & where they live.

Use paper from the blue bin (project paper) or ask me for larger paper if you need it. Draw in pencil, outline then color . . . other options include collage(magazines) or a painting . . . or a COMBO.

• Design 5 personal logo ideas (concepts) for your "brand".

Use paper from the red bin (homework paper) or ask me for larger paper if you need it. Draw in pencil, outline then color . . . other options include computer programs (Microsoft WORD, Google drawing) or APPS.

• Draw a scene from an animal's point-of-view.

Use LARGE project paper (in-between the red & blue bins by the projector screen) Draw in pencil, outline then color . . . other options include painting . . . or a COMBO.

• Design a new school locker : REIMAGINE the design for our 21st century needs.

Use whatever paper works for the size locker you're creating.

Draw in pencil, outline then color . . . other options include collage (magazines), painting or with the computer . . . or a COMBO.

· Think up a brand new restaurant and create a menu.

The menu should contain food, beverage & dessert options on one side (if it applies) as well as a restaurant logo and cartoon of your executive chef on the other.

Use whatever paper works for the size menu you're creating.

Draw in pencil, outline then color ... other options include collage (magazines), painting or with the computer ... or a COMBO.

- Create a self-portrait as if you were part or all... mechanical structure or machine. Use paper from the blue bin (project paper) or ask me for larger paper if you need it. Draw in pencil, outline then color.
- Draw a <u>famous</u> bridge over a small body of water . . . for example a bathtub or puddle. Use paper from the blue bin (project paper) or ask me for larger paper if you need it. Draw in pencil, outline then color.
- Illustrate the word "respect" in artist Vincent Van Gogh's style.

Use paper from the blue bin (project paper) or ask me for larger paper if you need it. Draw in pencil, outline then color.

• Illustrate the word "learning" in artist Theodor Geisel's style.

Use paper from the blue bin (project paper) or ask me for larger paper if you need it. Draw in pencil, outline then color.

• Illustrate the word "hard work" in artist Tim Burton's style.

Use paper from the blue bin (project paper) or ask me for larger paper if you need it. Draw in pencil then outline in black sharpie.

• Illustrate the word "peace" in artist Joan Miro's style.

Use paper from the blue bin (project paper) or ask me for larger paper if you need it. Cut your simple designs and ideas out of construction paper and glue.

- Illustrate the word "community" in artist Keith Haring's style. Use paper from the blue bin (project paper) or ask me for larger paper if you need it. Draw in pencil, outline then color.
- RE-DESIGN an everyday object... label the parts, materials & changes. Use paper from the blue bin (project paper) or ask me for larger paper if you need it. Draw in pencil, outline then color......Don't forget to label.
- Build a prototype of your object out of cardboard or tagboard and objects such as egg cartons, Styrofoam, straws, etc. that you find at home.
