WHAT MAKES "GOOD" ART ??? Do you know the "RECIPE for SUCCESS" ??

This school year you will learn about and experience many of the following . . .

MEDIUM = the materials you use to make art with (ex. Tempera paint, clay, colored pencils, etc.)

<u>ARTIST</u> = the person who creates a work of art (ex. Van Gogh, Jackson Pollock, Rembrandt, etc.)

<u>GENRE</u> = *period of time for a certain style of artwork* (Impressionism, Pop Art, Pointillism, etc.)

The ELEMENTS OF DESIGN = color, value, line, form/shape, space & texture

<u>The PRINCIPLES OF ART</u> = balance, variety, harmony, emphasis, proportion, movement, rhythm & unity

<u>**CAREERS IN ART</u>** = In terms of national impact, the nonprofit arts were found to compose a \$36.8 billion industry in the United States. That number jumps to \$314 billion when the commercial arts sector is added.</u>

I know that some students don't consider themselves "artists", but I believe that all students can be punctual, follow directions, hand in all class work/homework, be creative, explore possibilities and ask well-thought out questions.
