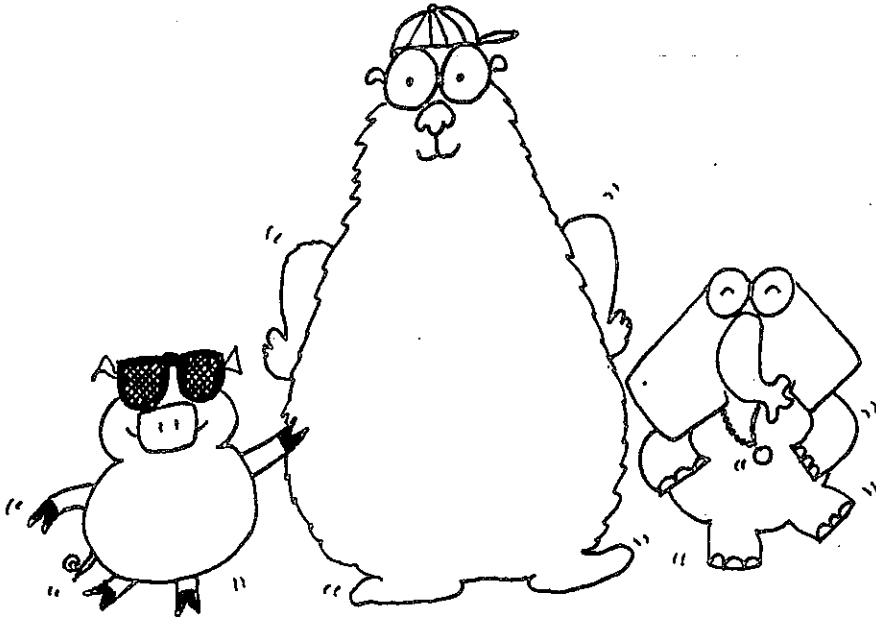

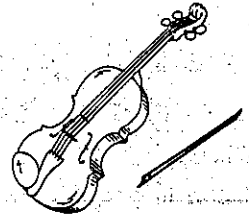

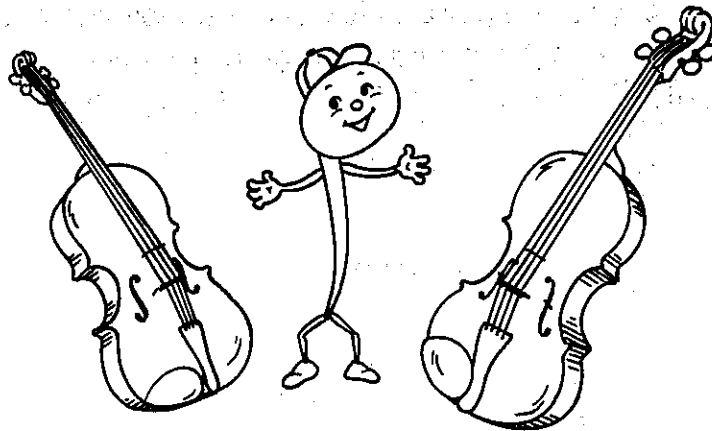
VIOLA

The viola is a little larger than a violin. Like the violin, the viola has four strings. The player can either pluck the strings or draw a bow across them. Most often, the player uses a bow because it makes the strings vibrate longer.



Like the violin, the viola is made of wood and is mostly hollow inside. The player holds the instrument between the jaw and shoulder. One hand holds the bow, and the other hand is used to "stop" the strings by pressing down along the viola's neck.

Because the viola is bigger and has longer strings, it has a lower tone than the violin. Like the violin, it may play the melody. Because of its huskier sound, it may also fill in the harmony. The viola is very good at expressing sadness and gloom.
