Online Protocols For Students and Parents / Guardians

- Students are expected to attend online classes daily. Attendance will be taken.
- Students are expected to participate for the duration of each class session.
- Students must complete all classwork assignments in a timely manner.
- Students are expected to complete all homework assignments by their due date.
- Students will be part of a respectful, caring, nurturing, environment that fosters social emotional learning.
- Parents/Guardians are asked to please monitor/supervise students while online and offline completing tasks during school hours.
- Thank you so much for your support and guidance during this difficult time.

School Reopening Plan

Health and Safety

- Parents are responsible for checking their child's daily temperature and completing the Covid-19 questionnaire daily.
- Daily temperature screening for all students and staff upon entry to the school building. Any student with a fever will be escorted to the "Isolation Room" Via gymnasium entrance. Parents/ guardians will be notified immediately to pick up student. All symptomatic cases will be handled as if student were COVID-19 positive, until that diagnosis is ruled out.
- School entry times will be staggered to ensure proper social distancing.
- Visitations are prohibited until further notice.
- * Parents must provide a face covering daily. All students will always be required to wear a covering on the school bus and in the building. Face covering breaks while social distancing will be instituted.

Facilities

- Markers are placed throughout the building to ensure social distancing.
- Student bathrooms will be monitored to minimize the number of students in the bathroom at one time.
- Classroom desks are rearranged six feet apart.
- Custodial staff will clean frequently throughout the day to prevent the spread of infection.
- Sanitizers are available throughout the school building.
- Signs and daily announcements are used to inform students of the importance of safety precautions including hand washing and social distancing.

Nutrition

- **Breakfast and lunch will be provided to all students. " A Grab & Go" system will be used for breakfast. Students will eat breakfast in the classroom.**
- **Tables will be adequately spaced apart in the cafeteria and atrium to ensure social distancing during each lunch shift.**
- **Students cannot bring lunchboxes to school. Lunches from home must be placed in a disposable bag.**



Social Emotional Well -Being

Our goal is to create the mental, social, and emotional space for academic learning.

- A Multi- Tiered Systems of Support framework will be utilized to provide targeted support for all learners.
- The administration, Pupil Support and teachers will work collaboratively to support our students during this emotional time for everyone.
- Parents conferences, meetings, and workshops will be conducted virtually throughout the school year.

Teaching and Learning

- **Our goal is to provide a safe and supportive learning environment where all students can learn and be successful.**
- **Digital Platforms**
- Microsoft Teams, Nearpod, Clever will be used for remote/ hybrid learning.
- Social Emotional Learning (SEL) will be intergraded in student learning.
- IEP's will be implemented to the greatest extent possible.
- Multilingual Learners will receive their ENL services.
- Attendance is very important for both hybrid and remote learners.

- **Homework**
- ELA and Math will be given daily.
- ELA may include but not limited to 30 minutes of independent reading daily.
- Sumdog task will be given daily or weekly.
- Some assignments may be posted online, in the textbook, or in Teams notebooks which will be introduced shortly to all students.
- Assignment should be submitted in a timely manner.

Hybrid Instruction

- Students will complete some instruction in-person and some instruction online.
- Group A comes to school on Monday and Tuesday, unless otherwise notified.
- Group B comes to school on Thursday and Friday, unless otherwise notified.
- Each group receives 2 days of in person instruction at least 2 consecutive days of the week.
- Wednesday is Flex Day- Online remote instruction for all students, except Special Education ICT students and selected Multilingual Learners who will receive in person supplemental support.


