ROBERT HALMI Award-Winning Producer | Visionary CEO | Patron of the Arts

Emmy and Golden Globe winner Robert Halmi is a producer of more than 400 film and television projects, the founder of the Hallmark Channel, and the visionary behind Great Point Studios, a mediafocused company specializing in film and television infrastructure.

Robert has been the Chief Executive Officer of four public companies, the first at age 25. As President and CEO of Hallmark Entertainment, he transformed the business from a small production company into one of the first modern studios, with production, distribution, and broadcast all under one umbrella. Under Robert's leadership, Hallmark Entertainment produced over 2,000 hours of original content. These productions received 458 Emmy nominations and garnered 133 Emmy Awards. Among Robert's many acclaimed productions is Lonesome Dove, which earned seven Emmy Awards and a Golden Globe for best miniseries.

In 2019, Robert Halmi embarked on bringing to life his vision of creating major new film and television production facilities across the U.S. and abroad. He formed Great Point Studios, a studio investment/management business specializing in film and television infrastructure. In January of 2022, Halmi's vision became a reality with the opening of Lionsgate Studios Yonkers, which is the first of many purpose-built TV and film production studios that Great Point intends to build, own and operate. The Company has since announced additional studio locations in Newark, NJ; Atlanta, GA; Buffalo, NY and the UK.

Halmi is an active member of the Academy of Television Arts & Sciences and serves on the board of the International Emmy Committee. He is also on the board of The Cold Water Conservation Fund.

- As businesses started opening again, JA was quick to revert to inperson options, providing many opportunities for our students to participate, including the following programs:
- Finance Park is a budgeting simulation that allows students to manage their expenses through various stages of life. In April, our students will participate in Building a Financially Capable Generation pilot program where they will engage with professionals from HSBC.
- In March, students participated in the Inspire Virtual Career Expo, where they we able to engage with over 40 different companies, including PepsiCo, PayPal, American Express, and FedEx, ask them questions and get responses in real time.
- Be Entrepreneurial Rapid Business Planning allows students to be coached through the process of coming up with an idea for a socially conscious business, using the Lean Canvas to determine the potential of their business ideas.
- The High School Heroes program allows the students to become teachers for the day, visit elementary schools and teach lessons in personal finance and entrepreneurship; this year students visited School 21 and Hostos Micro Society School.
- This year our two JA Student Ambassadors, Paulina Ledwon and Gabriela Zuniga, will receive grants for college for attending events and speaking about their JA experiences.

- Christie Lemaire, a hard-working senior currently enrolled in the Clinical Medical Assisting Program, aspires to become a nurse.
- She is a member of the Community Wellness Center, a student run organization that promotes health and wellness.
- Christie has volunteered on numerous projects, including the College and Career Fair, the Yonkers School Choice Fair, COVID vaccine distribution at Gorton and Riverside High School, and various Community Health Fairs, where she conducted blood screenings and educated community members pressure regarding exercise and proper nutrition.
- She also helped create a TikTok video as part of the mayor's initiative to raise awareness for the safety of the Covid vaccine.
- Within the Medical Assisting program, Christie has learned how to perform vital signs, take a past health history and chief complaint, perform EKG's, phlebotomy, and how to navigate patient management software.
- She is getting ready to start her internship at White Plains Hospital, where she will complete the required 72 hours for her Medical Assistant certification.
- Christie will be one of the first students who graduates with a certificate from Gorton since the program's inception 7 years ago.

- Patricia has volunteered on numerous projects, including the College and Career Fair, the Yonkers School Choice Fair, COVID vaccine distribution at Gorton and Riverside High School, and various Community Health Fairs, where she conducted blood pressure screenings and educated community members regarding exercise and proper nutrition.
- Within the EMT Program, Patricia has learned how to perform vital signs, take a chief complaint, transport a patient into and out of an ambulance, run a dispatch, and effectively perform first aid.
- In addition, Patricia excels in patient care scenarios during lab days and is always the first to volunteer to be the leader in her group.
- Christie aspires to become a surgeon and the CTE program at Gorton has given her a strong foundation for this career.



- Dawn Myers, one of the leaders for the Academy of Medical Professions, teaches our Junior Medical classes, which are College Link Anatomy and Physiology.
- She delivers instruction passionately and with enthusiasm, engaging her students in exciting activities on a daily basis, including hands on clinical labs, virtual reality medical programs, computer-based software platforms and instructional technology.
- The full integration and participation of Dawn's instructional practices in all aspects of Gorton's learning community is what sets her apart.
- Among the activities that she either heads or participates in are the Advisory board, Creators Club (after school program with Iona Liberty Partners that teaches students how to use 3D printers, laser cutters and fabrication equipment), Head coach for the Varsity Girls Basketball Team, Medical Academy Awards Ceremony and Dinner, and Guest Speakers Program.
- Dawn was instrumental in creation of the Emergency Medical Technician program, including the course, curriculum, supplies, and obtaining a donated EMT ambulette from Empress Emergency Services.
- Dawn also led the efforts in applying for and obtaining New York State Education Department approval for two CTE pathways, Medical Assisting and Marketing.



- Bernadette Amicucci, Senior Director of Clinical Education & Nurse Residency Program at White Plains Hospital, has worked tirelessly to support our students in the Medical Assisting Program, ever since she joined the Advisory Board.
- The goal of our program is to prepare students to enter the workforce, and White Plains Hospital has provided the work-based learning opportunities our students need to gain technical skills in the medical field.
- Bernadette has organized and coordinate several student trips to White Plains Hospital; during these trips students were able to practice clinical skills (such as how to assess vital signs, conduct EGKs, measure blood glucose, perform phlebotomy and use EPIC software) and observe various wards in the hospital (such as the lab, radiology, ORs, hyperbaric chamber and endoscopy).
- During their last trip to the hospital, students were able to debrief surgical rounds with nurses from the hospital, which included the following scenarios: Thyroid Surgery post-op care, neurosurgery postop care, glycemic control in the surgical patient, bariatric surgery and post-op care, and anesthesia.
- Bernadette was also instrumental in setting up work-based learning opportunities for students in the satellite offices of White Plains Hospital; as a result, 10 students received internships, during which they accumulated the 72 hours needed for state certification.
- The success of our program has a lot to do with Bernadette's love of the program and the support that she provides.



- WCC faculty has mentored and collaborated with YMA faculty in the implementation of the program.
- Westchester Community College also partners with YMA through the Early College Experience (ECE) Program, in which students enroll in Dual Enrollment courses taught by YMA teachers who are vetted to offer college credits through WCC.




- Rafael Valle began the automotive program in 2021 with the Introduction to Auto Mechanics course, in which he earned a 92%.
- Although this is an introductory course, it is very hands-on, and the reading and writing skills needed mirror post-secondary classes.


• Great Point Studios is interested in developing local talent to staff the various productions that will be filmed in Yonkers.
