

# How to Register in PowerSchool for Your Classes Next School Year

To access “Class Registration” you must sign in on a web browser. (ie. Chrome or Internet Explorer)

Username: Your ID Number (876543)

Password: Your 8-digit Birthdate (01202021)

Once you have logged in, click on “Class Registration” in the left side column.

You will then see a list of **subject areas** where you will have the option to request your classes. Some classes and assignments are grade specific and you will not have a choice. (For example: English 10 is only for 10<sup>th</sup> graders and 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> graders have a specific lunch period.)

When you click the edit button (the pencil) you will get a pop-out menu of the classes you are able to take. (Please be sure to check with your guidance counselor.) For example, If you have already taken Earth Science and Living Environment, put a check in the box next to **Chemistry**. After you choose, scroll down and click **“okay”**.
