Homework is meant to reinforce skills learned throughout the day. Please make sure that your child reads at least 30 minutes every night at home. Children will become better readers if they read daily. Reading helps to increase fluency, comprehension, and vocabulary.

Please have your child study and learn multiplication facts over the summer. Knowing multiplication facts is the foundation for most math skills and concepts learned in 4th grade. It is vitally important and will help your child be successful in math.

Finally, it is important that your child comes to school every day. It is essential that your child should start his/her day with a healthy breakfast and arrive at school on time. **School begins promptly at 8:35 a.m.** Consistent attendance is necessary for students to thrive and achieve success academically.
