



## So you can complete the FAFSA. . .

1. At least three days **BEFORE** the event, apply for FSA ID at <https://fsaid.ed.gov> (necessary to submit FAFSA)

**NOTE: Students and parents both have to create an FSA ID, even if they have previously filed for FAFSA**

2. **Bring the following information with you:**

- o Student's and parents' social security numbers and dates of birth
- o Students Alien Registration Number (If Non US Citizens)
- o Parents' marital status (if divorced/separated you will need month/year)
- o Federal and State Tax returns for students and parents (2018 1040/1040A/1040EZ forms)
- o 2018 W-2's for students and parents
- o Records of most up to date untaxed income such as child support etc. from such agencies as: Social Services, Social Security, and the Veterans Administration
- o Student and parent bank account balances if available; list of stocks, bonds and other assets; and both the estimated value and mortgage balance of other real estate (not including your home)
- o Student's drivers license number
