The clear folder this letter was in will be your child's homework/paperwork folder. All important papers will come home in this folder, so please check it daily. Today it has EMERGENGY cards that MUST be filled out and returned to school as long as other important papers. I would appreciate if you could get this paperwork back to me as soon as possible.
