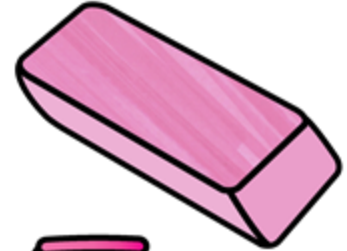

You cannot redo classwork that was not attempted.

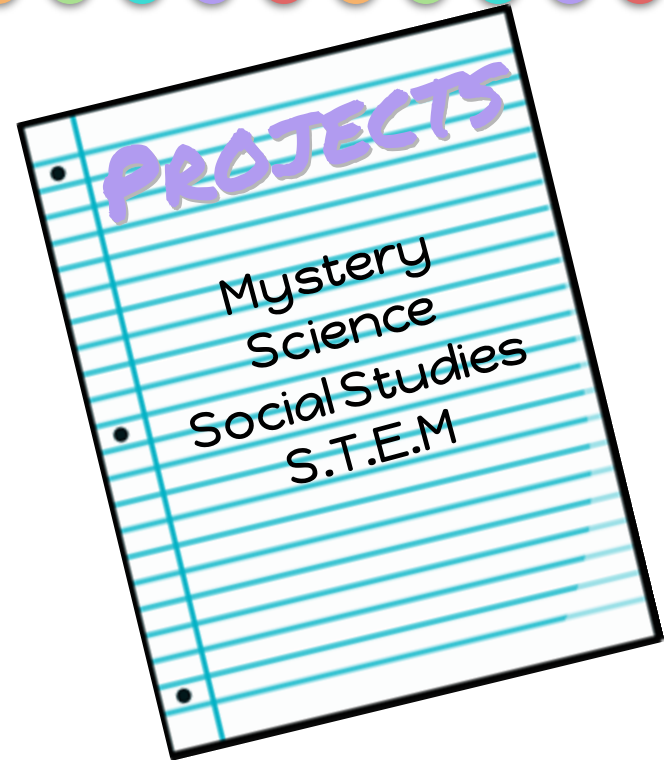
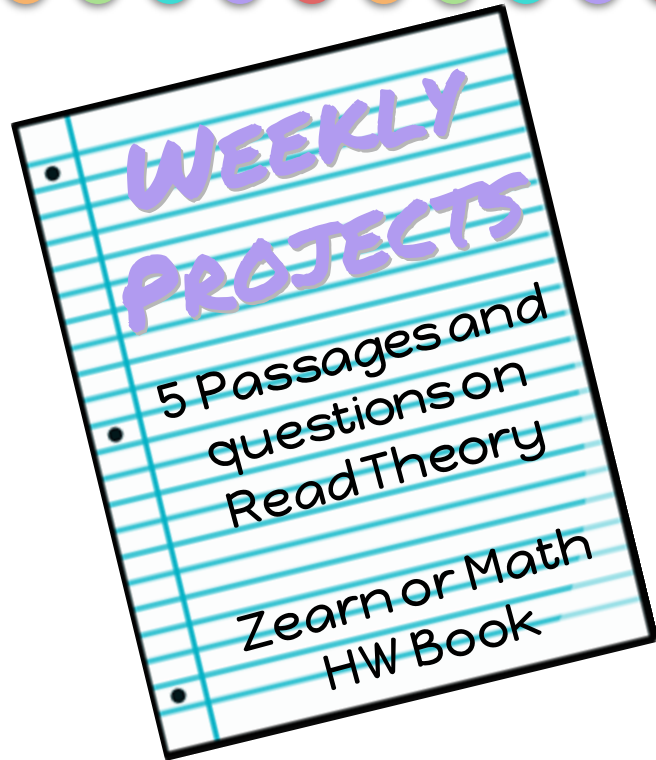
