#### **Counting Money**

In order to understand the monetary value of coins, children need to be able to recognize the physical differences between coins. For example, a penny is larger than a dime. Talk with your child about the money on the table. Talk about physical characteristics of each coin and the faces of famous Americans on them. Then count them. Which coin is there more of? Less of? Have your child explain his or her answer. Which coin do you like the most? Why? Once they can identify coins, talk about their value.
