Day 12 Lesson Plans

English Language Arts

- Print and assemble the take home book
“ Meet My Baby Brother” by following cutting directions on the book.
- Discuss what is it like to have a new baby brother or sister in the family. Discuss what babies do for ex: they cry, crawl, play, eat.
- Take a text walk with your child, having your him/her talk about what he/she sees on every page that tells us about what babies do or how they act. .
- Point out to your child that baby and brother begin with the letter B . Repeat the word “baby” and have your child identify the sound of B /b/.
- Read the book with your child, have them participate on the repetitive parts.
- Have your child express their favorite part of the book.

- Have your child do a retelling of the book with your support (if necessary).
- Be sure to your child uses transition words such as First, Next, Then, after that, At the end to engage in the retelling of the story.

Math

- Have a discussion with your child about the meanings of the words “what the word same means”. Another way of saying pictures that are the same is “matching pairs”.
- Print out the worksheet and have your child name some of the pictures on the worksheet.
- Have students match the pictures that are the same to **develop visual perception**.
- Follow directions on the worksheet to complete worksheet.
