Pre-Kindergarten Day 19 Lesson Plans

English Language Arts

- Print and assemble the take home book
 "Take a Trip with a Book" by following cutting directions on the book.
- Discuss how reading allows us to take a trip or travel. What do we mean by that? Do we get on train, plane or bus? No, we take a trip by visiting or learning through reading about places, or things without physically being there.
- Take a text walk with your child, having your him/her talk about what he/she sees on every page that shows how reading a book is like taking a trip. Where can we visit or what can we learn about through reading.
- Read the book with your child, have them participate on the repetitive parts.
- Have your child express their favorite part of the book.
- Have your child do a retelling of the book with your support (if necessary).

 Be sure to your child uses transition words such as First, Next, Then, after that, At the end to engage in the retelling of the story.

Math

- Print out the worksheet and have your child name the shapes on the worksheet.
- Have students trace the shapes and tell you a little about the shape. Circle is round, the square has four corners and four angles.
 Triangle has three corners and three angles.
- Follow directions on the worksheet to complete worksheet.
