Day 20 Lesson Plans

English Language Arts

- Print and assemble the take home book
“I Can Draw a Pig” by following cutting directions on the book.
- Take a text walk with your child, having your him/her talk about what he/she sees on every page that shows how we can use shapes to draw a pig.
- Point out to your child that pig begins with the letter P. Repeat the word “pig” and have your child identify the sound of P /p/.
- Read the book with your child, have them participate on the repetitive parts.
- Have your child express their favorite part of the book.
- Have your child do a retelling of the book with your support (if necessary).
- Be sure to your child uses transition words such as First, Next, Then, after that, At the end to engage in the retelling of the story.

Math

- Print out the worksheet and have your child name the shapes on the worksheet.
- Have the child tell you as much as they can about the shapes, circle is round, the star has 5 points.
- Have the child trace the shapes.
- Follow directions on the worksheet to complete worksheet.
