Day 23 Lesson Plans

English Language Arts

- Print and assemble the take home book “Counting Bugs” by following cutting directions on the book.
- Discuss with your child that there are different types of bugs. Bugs are also called insects. The book you will read is a counting book and it will count the different types of bugs/insects we can find in nature.
- Take a text walk with your child, having your him/her talk about what he/she sees on every page what the children are doing to clean up in the text.
- Point out to your child that bugs begins with the letter B. Repeat the word “bugs” and have your child identify the sound of B /b/.
- Read the book with your child, have them participate on the repetitive parts.
- Have your child express their favorite part of the book.

- Have your child do a retelling of the book with your support (if necessary).
- Be sure to your child uses transition words such as First, Next, Then, after that, At the end to engage in the retelling of the story.
- Have your child complete the Letter B book by tracing capital and lowercase Bb. Have the child name the pictures that begin with the sound/b/ and have him/her isolate /b/ sound.

Math

- Print out the worksheet and have your child name some of the pictures on the worksheet.
- Have the child count the number of objects on the left and match them with the same amount of objects on the right.
- Follow directions on the worksheet to complete worksheet.
