Day 25 Lesson Plans

English Language Arts

• Print and assemble the take home book

"Hello Beach" by following cutting directions on the book.

- Discuss what we would see if we went to the beach: sun, sand, seagulls, whales, dolphins, shells, crabs.
- Take a text walk with your child, having your him/her talk about what he/she sees on every page that shows what the children would see if they went to the beach.
- Point out to your child that beach begins with the letter B. Repeat the word "beach" and have your child identify the sound of B/b/.
- Read the book with your child, have them participate on the repetitive parts.
- Have your child express their favorite part of the book.
- Have your child do a retelling of the book with your support (if necessary).

- Be sure to your child uses transition words such as First, Next, Then, after that, At the end to engage in the retelling of the story.
- Print worksheet "Help the Rabbit Find the Carrot". Have the child find and trace the path from the rabbit to the carrot.

Math

- Print out the worksheet "How Many".
- Have students names the different types of fruit sold at the market.
- Have students count how many of each type of fruit is displayed at the market and write the number on the line.
- Follow Parent suggestions and directions on the worksheet to complete worksheet.
- Print the worksheet "Counting Money". Follow the Parent suggestions and directions for introducing the counting of money.
