Pre-Kindergarten Day 9 Lesson Plans

English Language Arts

- Print and assemble the take home book
 "My Loose Tooth" by following cutting directions on the book.
- Discuss what it is like to have a loose tooth in your mouth with your child. Talk about what children do when their tooth is loose, they wiggle it to try and get it out.
- Take a text walk with your child, having your him/her talk about what he/she sees on every page that tells us about what kids do when they have a loose tooth in their mouth.
- Point out to your child that tooth starts with the letter T. Repeat the word tooth and have your child identify the sound of T /t/.
- Read the book with your child, have them participate on the repetitive parts.
- Have your child express their favorite part of the book.

- Have your child do a retelling of the book with your support (if necessary).
- Be sure to your child uses transition words such as First, Next, Then, after that, At the end to engage in the retelling of the story.

Math

- Have a discussion with your child about the meanings of the word "opposites". An important math concept is the ability to group, classify, and understand proportions.
- Print out the worksheet and have your child look at the different gift boxes on the worksheet.
- Have students tell you how they are different and why?
- Follow directions on the worksheet to complete worksheet.
