

Goals

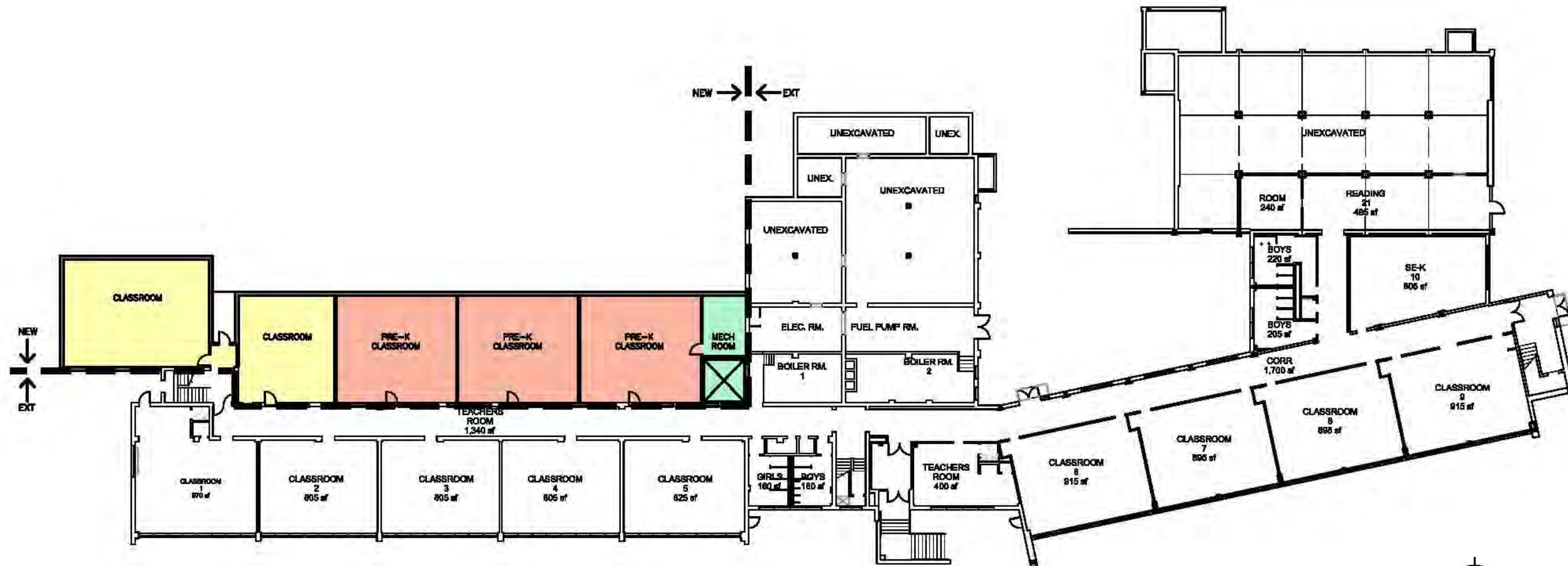
- Create additional space for classrooms through cost effective and 'green' or sustainable construction methods

- Strive for sustainable design and construction methods that are eco-conscious and economical.

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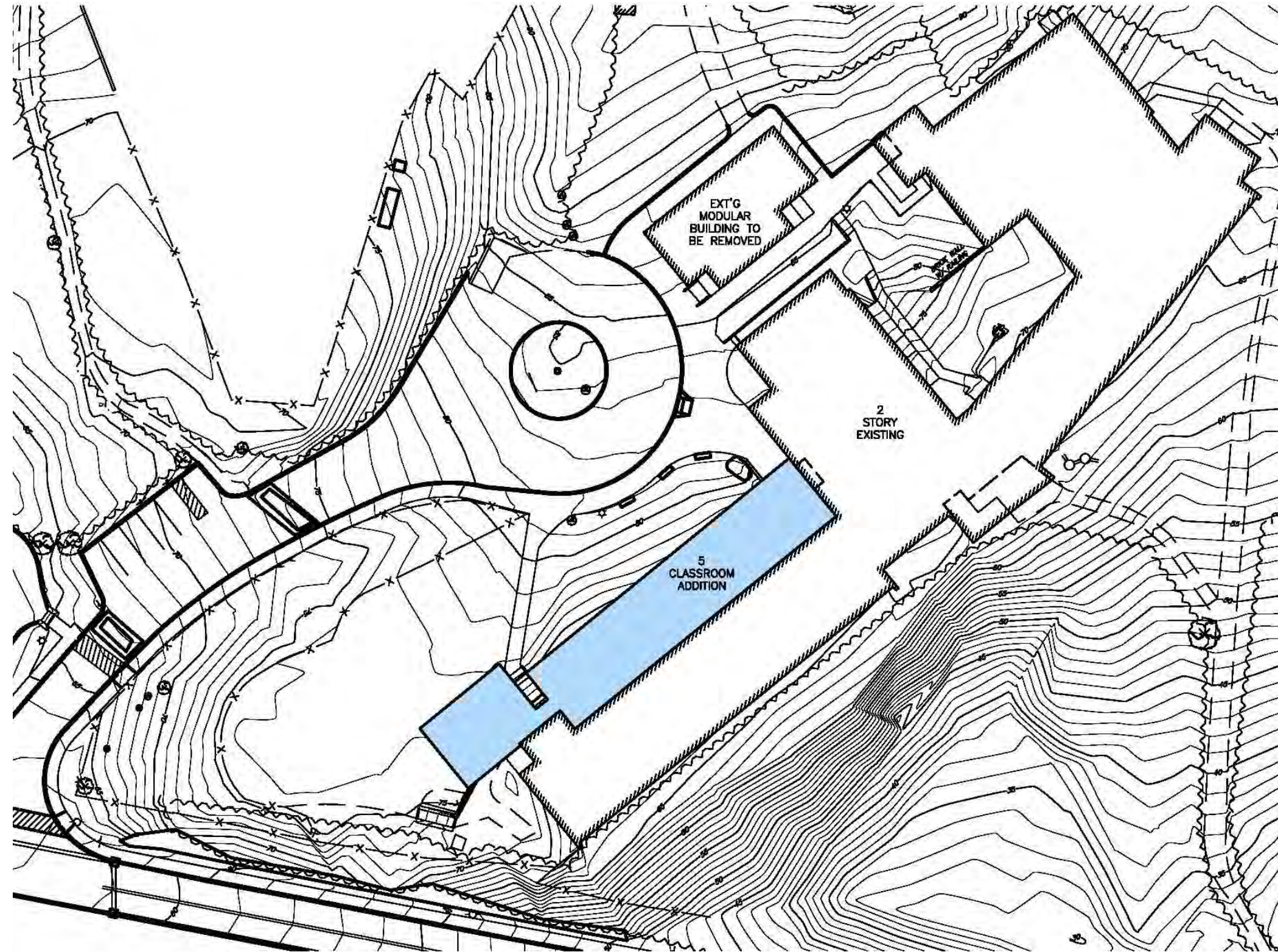
Schematic First Floor Plan

Schematic Massing Perspective



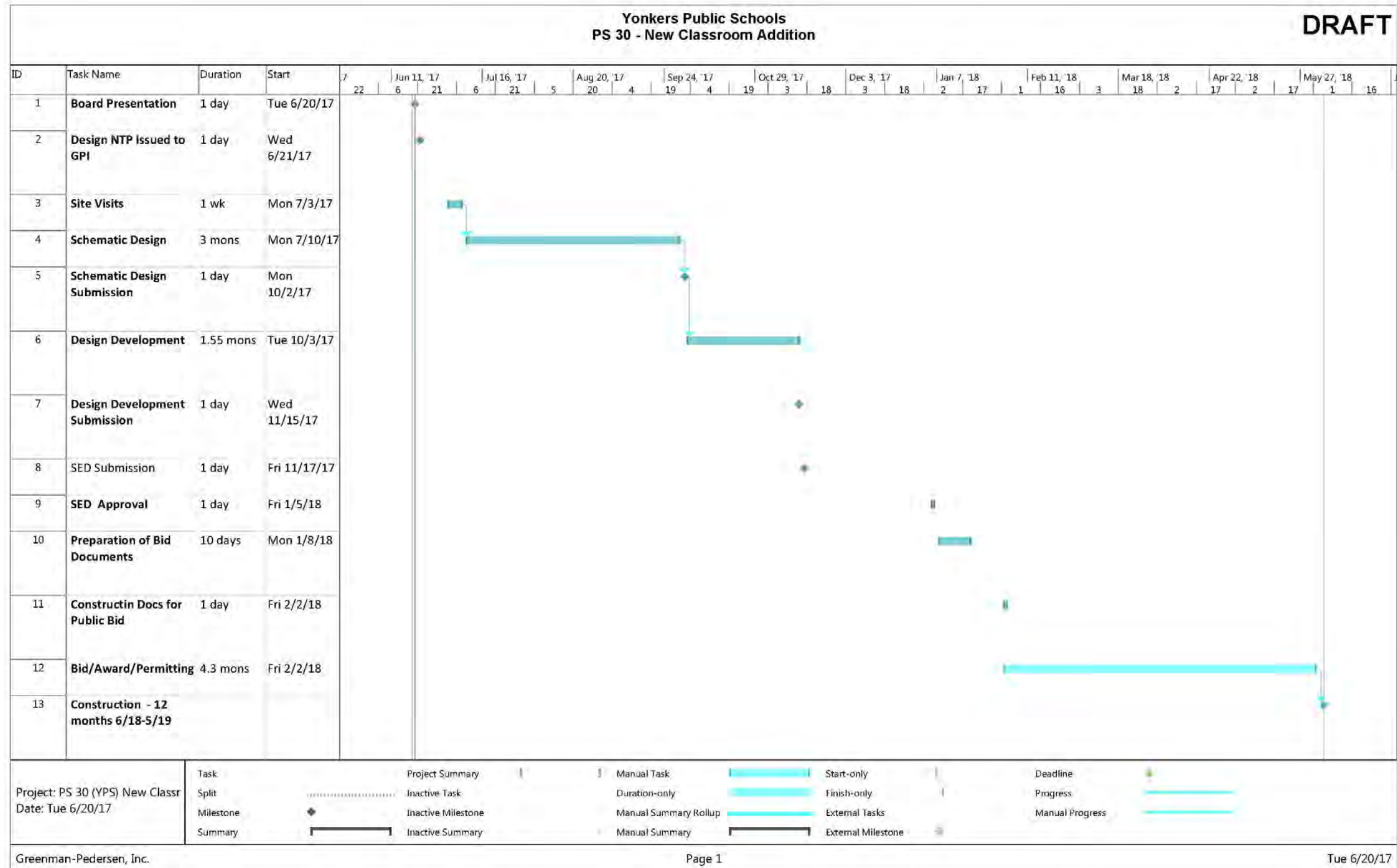

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Project Schedule



Enrollment, Budgets & State Aid

- The addition to Public School 30 will add 5 classrooms, 2 of them being general classrooms and the other 3 designated as Pre-K. This would add a total of 5,347 sf to the school.
- The initial amount is estimated to be around \$5 million. 100% of which should be reimbursable under SSBA
- The rest of the project is estimated to be around \$5 million. 70% of which should be reimbursable under normal building aid
- The total project cost is \$10 million, local share is \$1.5 million.
