Enrico Fermi School Closed through October 26, 2020 Due to COVID-19

Remote Instruction will begin Tomorrow, October 15, 2020

Yonkers, NY – Based on the recommendation of the Westchester County Health Department, Superintendent of Schools Dr. Edwin M. Quezada announced that the Enrico Fermi School will be closed to non-essential staff until Friday, October 23, 2020. All students will continue learning using the District’s Remote Instruction model. On Monday, October 26, 2020, the school will reopen for student and staff resuming Hybrid Instruction.

Today, a second staff member from the Enrico Fermi School notified the District that the individual tested positive for COVID-19. The staff member was last at work on Friday, October 9, 2020. The District followed with fidelity all appropriate guidelines from the CDC and is working directly with the Westchester County Health Department regarding the protocols for contact tracing. All known close contacts identified by the staff member were notified by the District’s medical staff.

Dr. Ammir Rabadi, Yonkers Public Schools Chief Physician, encourages anyone experiencing a fever over 100 °F or any other COVID-19 symptoms to contact their medical provider.
