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Draw an Owl Step-by-Step (Grade 2 & 3)

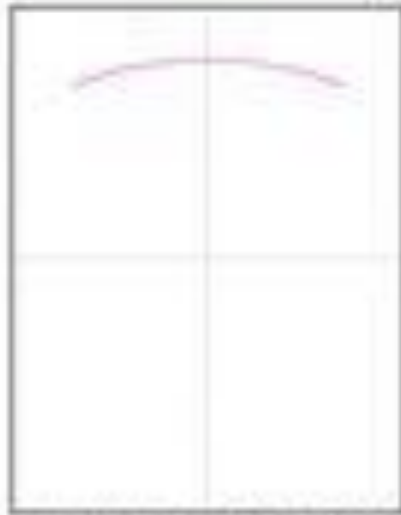

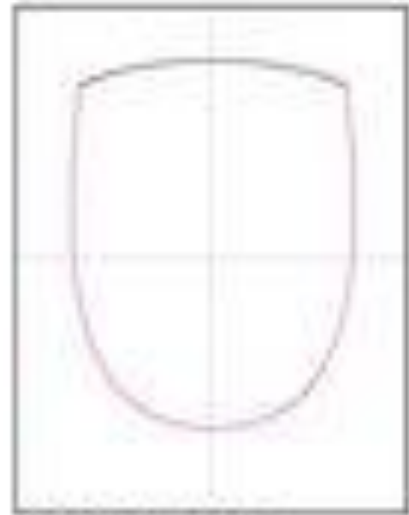
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Supplies: Liquid watercolor, Black Sharpie, Crayola Metallic Markers.



1. Make guide lines. Draw a curve.



2. Add a large U shape.



3. Draw two ears and beak.



4. Draw two large circles.



5. Draw inside eyes and wings.



6. Add claws and chin lines.



7. Draw patterns on body.



8. Draw branch under claws.

DRAW A TURTLE (GRADES 3-6)

Follow the steps in the pictures to the right.

1-Use whatever supplies you have at home.

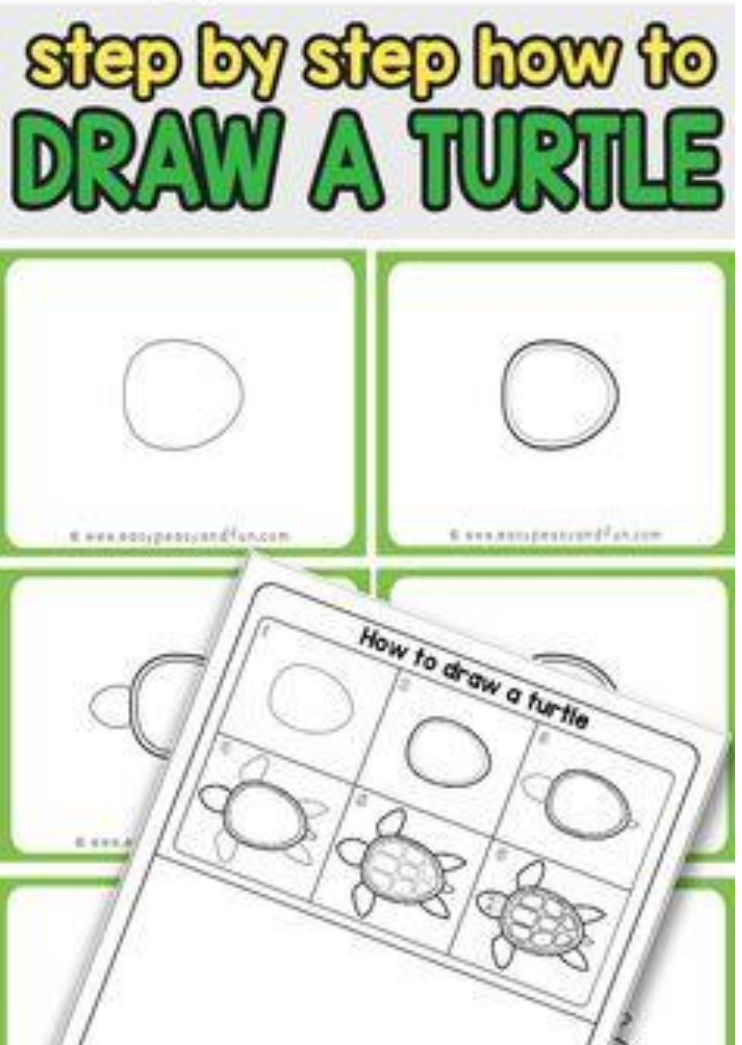
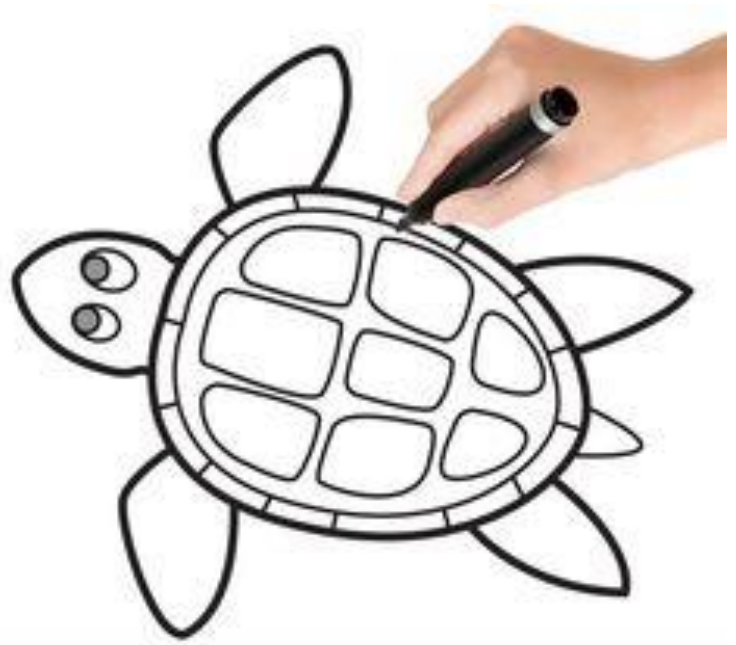
2-Outline the shapes with light pencil lines.

3-Trace the outlines using a black marker or crayon.

3-Color inside the spaces with crayons, marker or watercolors.

4-Create the ocean waves in the space around the turtle.

You can use crayon first then watercolor over the crayon. Watch what happens.

Google Sandra Silberzweig to look at the artwork she created on the internet. Follow the steps in the chart to follow. Use whatever supplies you have at home.

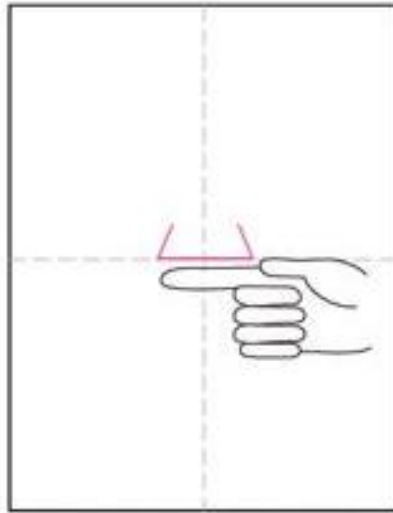
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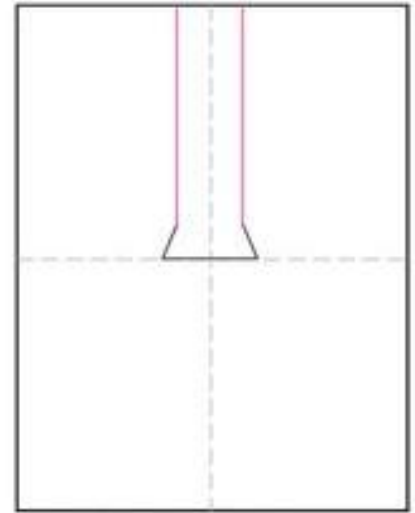




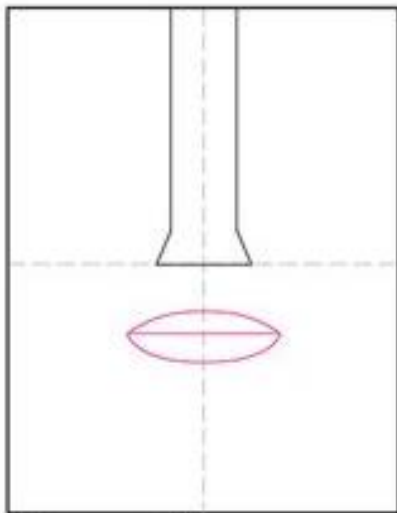
Supplies: Marker, crayons, liquid watercolor paint, watercolor paper



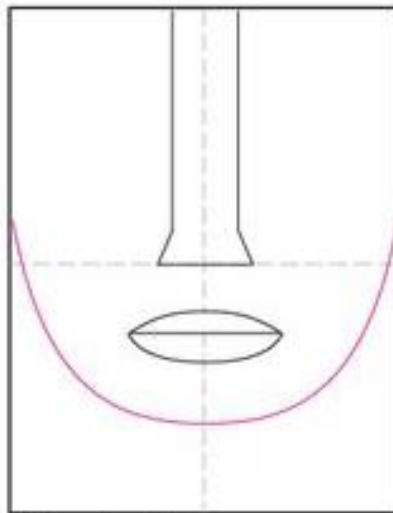
1. Make guide lines. Start the nose.



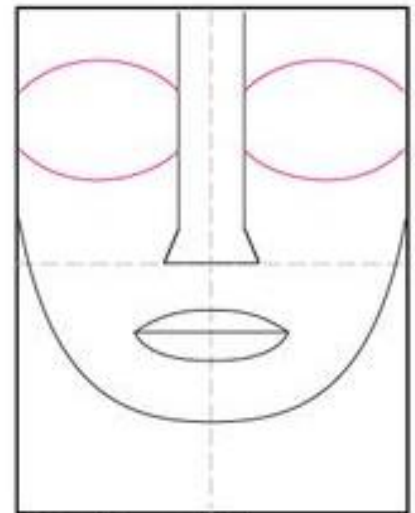
2. Add two lines going up.



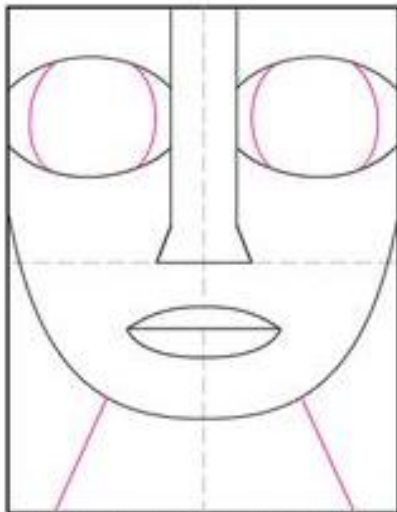
3. Draw a mouth.



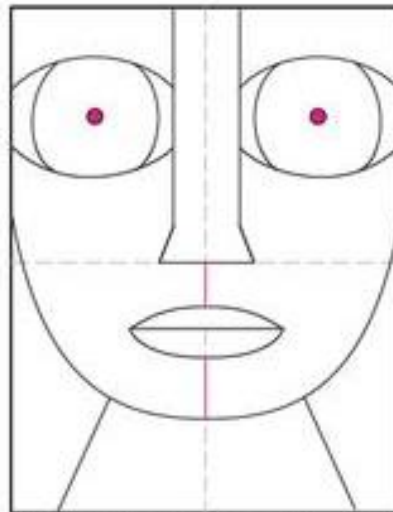
4. Draw the chin.



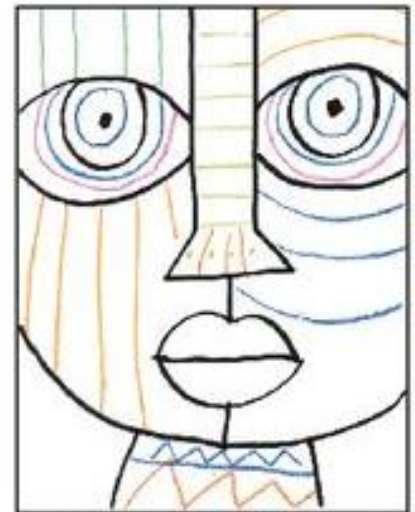
5. Draw four curved lines.

7. Add center of eyes and mouth lines.



8. Trace, add crayon patterns, paint.
