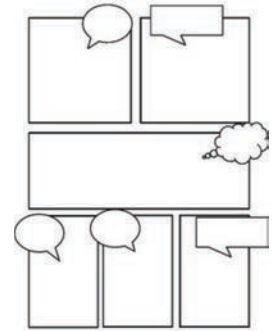

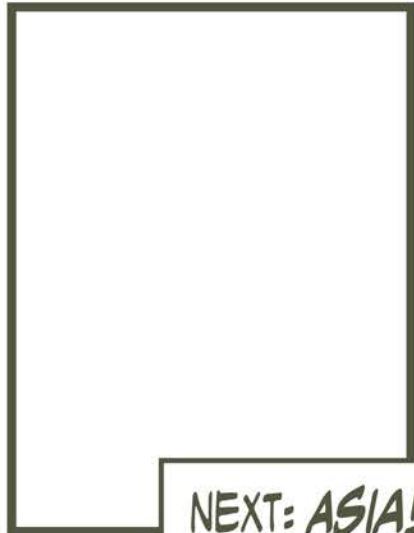
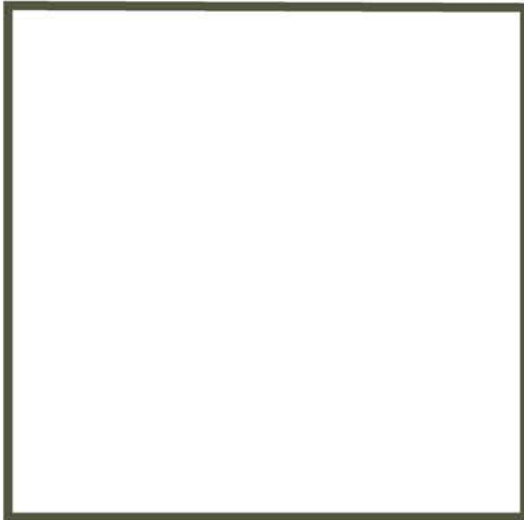
Each day Monday through Thursday:

2. Write and draw a new panel from the week's Travel Log Graphic Novel page to complete the page by Thursday (use Flex Friday to catch up if needed).

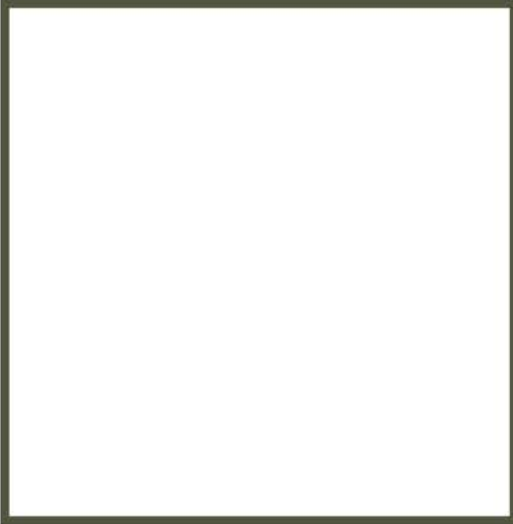
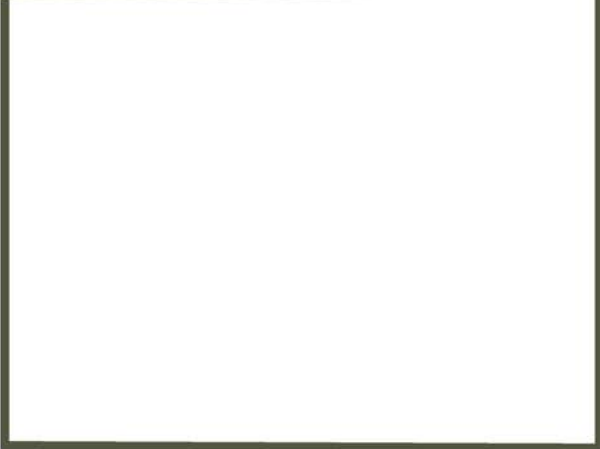
3. Interview a family member to gradually document and design your Ancestral Family Tree by the end of the project.

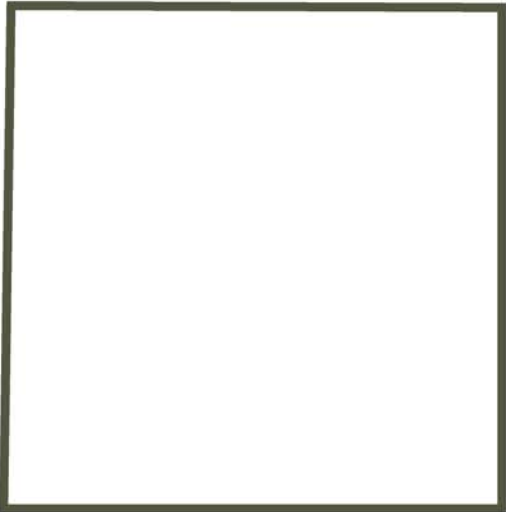

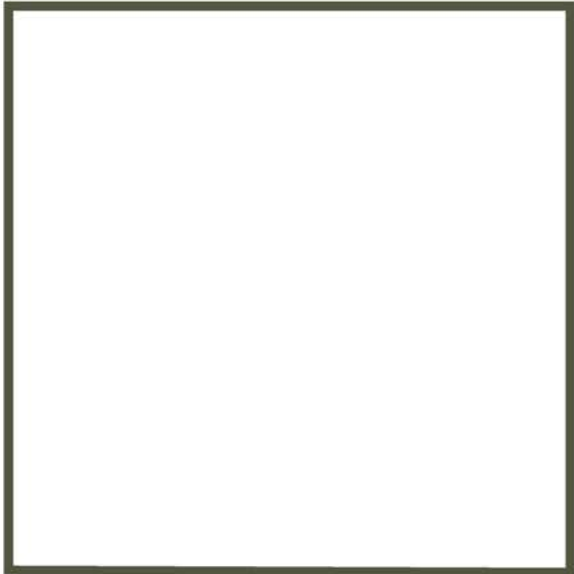
