

#### SUMMER SESSION ELIGIBILITY

The summer session program is restricted to those students who have failed a course during the academic year and who were in good attendance in that class. Specifically, according to the District's Attendance Policy, a student may not have been absent more than 24 times for a full credit course or more than 12 times for a half (1/2) credit course.

#### **GUIDELINES FOR COURSES AND CREDIT**

- All courses are to be considered make-ups. They are not intended for acceleration or enrichment.
- Credits will be granted by the home school principal upon successful completion of each course. This policy also applies to students who take courses in any New York State approved out-of-district Summer Session program.
- Students who successfully pass a course that would normally end in a New York State Regents Examination, will receive Regents credit.
- Enrollment will be on a first-come, first-serve basis according to the registration schedule. However, priority will be given to 8th and 12th graders. When maximum class enrollment (25 students) is achieved, courses will be closed. Courses with enrollments of fewer than 15 students may be closed.
- All courses offered will be subject to District pupil/teacher ratio levels.
- Students may not take more than two courses with the exception of 8th graders and 12th graders. In such cases, special permission is required from their **home school principal in writing.**

#### **COVID-19 PROTOCOLS**

- Students need to complete a COVID-19 Questionnaire daily prior to entering the building
- Temperature screening will be done daily
- A face mask must be worn at all times.

#### REGISTRATION

Registration will be done by the student's home school submitting a list of students and courses required. Students will be contacted on Wednesday, June 30, 2021 with regards to which class(es) they are registered for.

#### **REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION**

- <u>Yonkers Public Schools students and Yonkers Non-Public School</u> <u>students</u> must bring the following in order to register: a signed registration form and a copy of their final report card. High School students must also bring a copy of their transcript.
- <u>Out-of-District students (non-Yonkers residents)</u> must bring the following: final report card, authorization from their school to attend Summer Session, and proof of residency.

Students who appear without these documents will not be permitted to register. There will be no student registration once the Summer Session program begins on July 1.

#### TUITION

All non-resident students who wish to attend Yonkers Summer Session must pay \$300.00 per course for tuition plus the \$3.00 registration fee.

Registration and/or tuition are payable in cash, check or money order made out to: **Yonkers Public Schools Summer Session**. Full registration and/or tuition are due at registration. There will be no refunds unless the course is under-enrolled and closed.

### ATTENDANCE

There will be twenty-six (26) days of instruction for all students enrolled in the Yonkers Summer Session. Instruction begins on July 1 and ends on August 11. Final Examinations are scheduled for August 12-13. Students with absences and/or tardiness in a course exceeding two (2) instructional school days may not be permitted to take exams or receive any credit unless authorized by the Yonkers Summer Session Principal.

Tardiness to class up to fifteen minutes will be considered half an absence; more than fifteen minutes will be considered a full absence. Students will be allowed to stay for instruction. Parents/Guardians are requested to call the school between 8:30 a.m. and 11:30 a.m. on the day a student will be absent at (914) 376-8191. A note must accompany the student on their return to class.
