- Your child and all members of your household must use appropriate language
- Your child and all members of your household must be dressed appropriately
- Your child, parents/guardians and care givers are prohibited from recording the live classes in any media application
- Your child is prohibited from entering any class until the teacher is present
- If the teacher is not present in the class then the student must exit from the class

- Your child is prohibited from using the chat room and the share screen unless requested by the classroom teacher
- Your child should be sitting at a desk or table with their school supplies at hand

The faculty and administration will continue to bring awareness of the dangers of the misuse of digital platforms. In addition, we will have a Virtual Assembly with students to address digital learning etiquette and expectations, as well as our annual anti-bullying and anti-harassment presentations in accordance with the Dignity for All Students Act.
