Today, Andrea Heagerty speaks about Billie Jean King -- Good morning. My name in Andrea Heagerty, and today's quote for women's history is from Billie Jean King Champions keep playing until they get it right. She means that real champions don't quit, no matter what. Billie Jean King became the top-ranked women's tennis player by 1967. In 1973, she formed the Women's Tennis Association and famously defeated Bobby Riggs in the "Battle of the Sexes." Altogether, King won 39 major singles, doubles and mixeddoubles championships, including a record 20 at Wimbledon. King faced considerable backlash due to her life off the court, but she continued her work as an influential social activist after retiring from tennis
