Diana Trujillo is a Colombian American aerospace engineer at NASA’s Jet Propulsion Laboratory, where she currently is a Flight Director and helped create the Robotic Arm System for the Mars Perseverance mission. She was born and grew up in Colombia, Diana immigrated to the United States at the age of 17 to work for NASA. On February 18, 2021, Trujillo hosted the first ever Spanish-language NASA transmission of a planetary landing, for the Perseverance rover landing on Mars.
